It is my belief that everyone has something to share and has the ability or capacity to contribute something for the good and the growth of our faith community. It is a task not just for one, but a task and a responsibility for all of us in pursuing our vision and fulfilling our mission. Everyone at St. Timothy's is important, valuable, welcomed, and loved.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

WHY THE TV MONITOR IN THE CHURCH

Certain new things or changes could stir up different reactions from different people. As a Pastor, I am always looking on the positive side for how to promote the active participation of the people when it comes to celebrating the Mass, for which I am very passionate. I just want to make some clarifications on the use of the TV monitor in the Church, in the hope that everyone will understand why it is temporarily placed there.

- First of all, it's not a permanent structure because I do not want to destroy the beautiful architecture of our Church. It is mounted on a rolling stand that we can put out or remove anytime.
- The use of the monitor was discussed in our staff meeting and I did not simply put it out on my own decision. I always consult and I always listen to advice and suggestions.
- The use of the monitor is not only keeping with our technological era or imitating the practices of other Churches, but the monitor will help as our worship aid, with the purpose of increasing the participation of the people in the responses, especially during this time when we do not distribute missalettes, song books or worship aids.
- I notice that people do not respond or join in some prayers, it's probably because they do not memorize the prayers, like the Creed. I also notice that some are using their cell phones during Mass to follow the Mass responses (hopefully not other things).
- There is also a suggestion from the people to include on the monitor songs and readings during the Mass.
- Our school Principal would like to use the monitor for our school children to enhance their participation in the responses during their school Mass. They do not have to print the Order of the Mass constantly for the use of the children.
- I have weighed the pros and cons of this before making my decision, and as I have said, it is not a fixed structure and it helps in promoting participation in the responses, especially during this Covid time when we do not have the books.

Thank you for understanding. Let us lift up our hearts and raise our voices to worship our Lord. God bless us all!

ST. TIMOTHY CHURCH DIRECTIVES FOR MASS

The Archbishop of the Archdiocese of Los Angeles, Most Reverend Jose Gomez, announced the following:

<u>Effective June 19, 2021:</u> The dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation in response to the coronavirus for the Archdiocese of Los Angeles is lifted. Those who have serious and legitimate reasons are dispensed.

Updated directives as of August 7, 2021



 In the Archdiocese of Los Angeles, face coverings must be used indoors for the safety and protection of all people regardless of vaccination status in accordance with the

mandates of the County of Los Angeles.

- Please self-attest your health and exposure level to the COVID-19 virus before attending Mass.
- Hand sanitation is available at church entrances.
- Please wash your hands, maintain good hygiene.
- Only bread will be given at Communion and only into the hand.
- Liturgical singing can take place while wearing face coverings.
- Collections can be taken.
- Entrance and recessional processions are allowed, as well as the gifts of bread and wine.
- Registration is not required to attend.
- There will be no assigned seating.
- Please be respectful of spacing: allow 3' between households.

STATEMENT ON RELIGIOUS EXEMPTION FOR VACCINATION AGAINST COVID-19



Archdiocese of Los Angeles

The Archdiocese of Los Angeles, in accordance with the Vatican and the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB), recommends that all members of the Catholic community, who are able to receive a COVID-19 vaccine, should do so.

"Receiving one of the COVID-19 vaccines ought to be understood as an act of charity toward the other members of our community. In this way, being vaccinated safely against COVID-19 should be considered an act of love of our neighbor and part of our moral responsibility for the common good." -USCCB, Moral Considerations Regarding the New COVID-19 Vaccines

Since the vaccinations for COVID-19 have been found morally acceptable to protect the lives and ensure the health of all in our communities, the Archdiocese will not provide religious exemptions to receiving a vaccine against COVID-19. Parishes are not to provide religious exemption letters regarding the COVID-19 vaccination.


