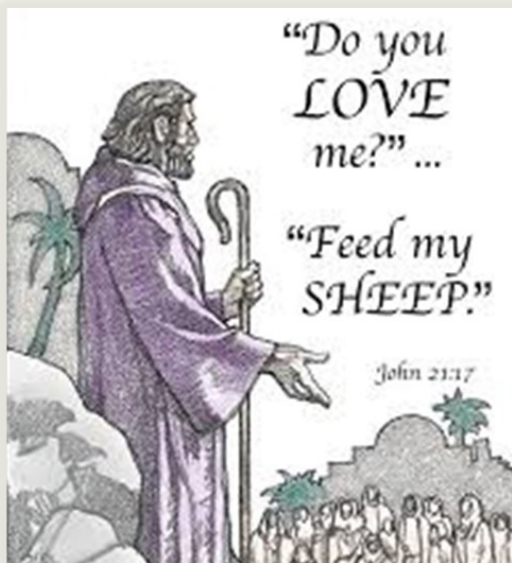


Welcome Maria!

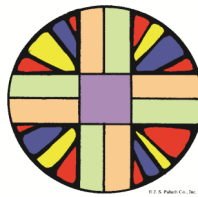

THE NINE MONTHS OF THE CHILD JESUS IN THE WOMB OF MARY

THE EIGHTH MONTH – OCTOBER 25 TO NOVEMBER 25

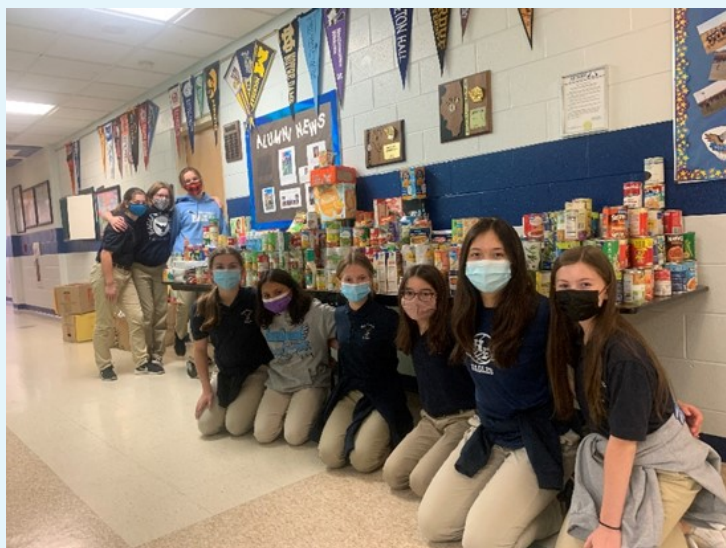


News from the Eagle's Nest

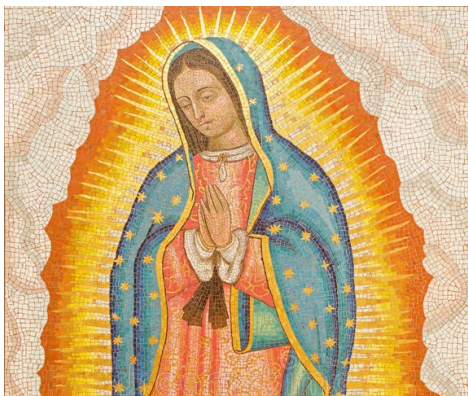
