## The Mass Explained: How are the readings chosen?

Scripture is proclaimed according to a schedule of passages called a lectionary.

Lectionaries are organized on a three year cycle: Year A, B and C.

Year A=Matthew Year B=Mark Year C= Luke

John is used in the Christmas, Lent and Easter season as well as in the year of Mark, since that Gospel is shorter than the others.

We are currently in Year B, and a new cycle begins in Advent, which is the start of a new liturgical year.

The first reading comes from the Old Testament or from the Acts of the Apostles during the Easter season. The second reading comes from the New Testament, or the Book of Revelation during Easter.

During Advent, Christmas, Lent, and Easter, the second reading is chosen for its particular content. Otherwise a letter is begun on one Sunday, and its major portions are read in order over successive Sundays.






