The Mass Explained: The Gospel & Homily

During the reading of the Gospel, we stand in attentive reverence to the Word of God. We believe that Christ "is present in His Word, since it is He Himself who speaks when the holy Scriptures are read in the church" (Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy, #7).

During the opening procession at Mass, the Book of the Gospels is held high as a sign of reverence. When the Gospel is complete the priest or Deacon will kiss the Book of the Gospels because Jesus is present in His Word.

In the homily, the priest follows the example of Christ on the road to Emmaus, explaining and interpreting the Scriptures. This interpretation can be theological, moral, biblical, or catechetical. It may also prepare us for or point us toward what is about to follow: the Liturgy of the Eucharist.

The homily takes the Word of Christ and helps relate it to our lives. The Word of God must be broken open so it can be received and understood by all.

At least one of the engaged persons (or their parents) must be a registered and active parishioner of Holy Family. Weddings are not scheduled on Saturday evenings or Sundays.

Eucharistic Revival

The NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL "My Flesh for The Life of The World" begins on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, June 19th.

Throughout the United States every Diocese and Parish will celebrate this day in a very special way as we gather as a Church to celebrate the Mass and in many places to have a Eucharistic Procession. Bishop Hicks will be the Principal Celebrant at the 10:30 Mass at the Cathedral of St. Raymond Nonnatus in Joliet. After the Mass he will lead a Eucharistic Procession carrying the Monstrance around the block on which the Cathedral stands. Many of our parishes will also celebrate this Solemnity with a Eucharistic Procession on their grounds and even between parishes.


Everyone is welcome to the Mass at 10:30 and to join in the procession at the end of the Mass. Everyone is also invited to come to the Cathedral block around 11:30 and stand in prayer as the Eucharistic Procession passes by. The procession will end with Benediction inside the Cathedral.

This is the beginning of a three-year celebration of encountering Jesus in the Eucharist and celebrating that encounter by putting our faith into action. Let us all open our spiritual life to this great gift of this Eucharistic Revival with much joy and prayerfulness.
