Faith Explained: Confirmation

As we receive God the Son through the gift of the Eucharist, we receive God the Spirit through the sacrament of Confirmation. The son saved us from our sins to live as Children of God, and share in God's nature through the gift of the Holy Spirit. Confirmation in scripture can be found in JN 20:22 when Jesus "breathed on them, and said, "receive the Holy Spirit." As well as in Acts 2 when the Holy Spirit descended and flames appeared on each one of them.

The sacrament of confirmation completes our baptism, at whatever point we receive it, immediately after baptism as is done at the Easter Vigil, or at some time during adolescence as we currently practice. It has also been at the age of reason, but no matter what age, or how long after baptism, it nonetheless gives us the same grace, fruits, and gifts of the Holy Spirit.

"Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you?" (1Cor 6:19) Through our sacraments of initiation, baptism, confirmation and Eucharist, we have God dwelling within us. We are both body and soul, not souls with bodies, nor bodies with souls. We believe in a bodily resurrection, because God made us and as the saying goes, "God don't make no junk." God at creation called man and woman good, and we have to look at ourselves and others as good, treating our bodies and souls with dignity and respect. It is the devil who wants us to hate our bodies and separate them from our souls. We need to love ourselves and offer ourselves to God with all our mind, body, and soul and be a temple worthy of God to dwell in.

Arrangement must be made through the Parish Office at least 6 months prior to the date requested. Please do not reserve a hall or make other preparations before confirming the date with the Pastor. At least one of the engaged persons (or their parents) must be a registered and active parishioner of Holy Family. Weddings are not scheduled on Saturday evenings or Sundays.





St. Gianna Molla Respect Life Ministry





