Nourished by God's Word & Sacrament, as one family, we are called upon to share our faith in Jesus Christ & reach out to those in need.



Faith Explained: Eucharist

At Vatican II, the Church emphasized that the Eucharist is the source and summit of our faith. To state that, wasn't anything new, as St. Irenaeus, from the second century, said, "Our way of thinking is attuned to the Eucharist, and the Eucharist in turn confirms our way of thinking." The Eucharist is the Sacrament of Sacraments, that is why we receive the sacrament of the Eucharist when celebrating other sacraments such as baptism, when done at the Easter Vigil, confirmation, matrimony, holy orders, and prepare to receive the Eucharist by receiving the sacrament of reconciliation. The Eucharist is the "main thing," because the Eucharist is the body and blood of Christ. Jesus Christ is God the Son. Therefore God is truly present to us in a physical form, to be eaten by us to give us life. The very life in us that died when the first man and woman ate the forbidden fruit, is restored by eating the body and blood of our Christ. This is how he has chosen to dwell in us, and we become what we eat. The Eucharist is the vital imperative sacrament that makes us the Church that we are, and the Church that is nourished by the Eucharist. Without the Eucharist, we would be just like any other church. With the Eucharist we are the church with God dwelling with us, in us and through us.

June 11, 2023 is the Feast of Corpus Christi, and the beginning of a year of Eucharistic revival. We will have a Eucharistic Procession, an 40 hour Eucharistic Adoration with a Eucharistic speaker, and a pilgrimage. We hope you will contemplate, and meditate on the Eucharist throughout the year so that you grow closer to God and receive the body and blood of Christ as your daily bread.






St. Gianna Molla Respect Life Ministry






