### Faith Explained Sabbath

The Sabbath is a time of rest. It is where the term sabbatical comes from that our Pastor Fr. John has been on, taking time to rest. The commandment on the Sabbath is found in Exodus 20:8-11 "Remember the Sabbath day-keep it holy." Interestingly, this is the only commandment that God tells us to "remember." He knows that we will forget, we will get busy and get caught up in doing things, many good thing, even great things, but that's not what God wants us to constantly do. We are human beings, not human doings, God wants us to focus on our existence, and our relationship with Him. We are created in His image and likeness, but do we reflect that? How would we know if we never take the time to check and see? How much time do we take, where we are free from being busy? Take a Sabbath, a time without an agenda, without distraction, even without a prayer, and just sit there and let Him love you. God loves you as much as any priest or nun, He loves you as much as a millionaire or billionaire, He loves you as much as Cardinal Cupich, and as much as He loves Pope Francis. He also loves you as much as he loves the atheist, He loves your enemy, and He loves you as much as he loves everyone in jail. His love is endless, and we remember that and dwell in that love during our Sabbath.
