Blessed Broken Given

The next series of faith formation is titled Blessed Broken and Given, it seems appropriate as we are starting the Eucharistic Revival at the parish level. My hope is that for the entire year the focus will remain on the Eucharist, and that you'll get to hear stories from fellow parishioners about how their lives have been blessed, broken and given. Today is the solemnity of Corpus Christi, The Body and Blood of Christ. The Eucharist is the source and summit of our faith, it is something that no other religion even comes close to proclaiming. We profess that our God in a mystical way gives us his living Body to eat and Blood to drink. It is hard to explain and just as hard to understand, but it is possible to believed.

The Eucharist has been a part of my life since receiving my first communion when I was seven years old. Since then I have only missed Sunday Mass a handful of times. When I was a Junior in college, I attended a Youth 2000 weekend of Adoration, praise and worship, and reconciliation retreat and gained a much deeper appreciation of the Eucharist. The Eucharist being the Body and Blood of the God the Son, there's always a mystery of truth that has continued to unfold throughout my life. As much as I'd like to be a super saint, singly devoted to the Eucharist, I am far from it, but the faith I have, the size of a mustard seed, I ask Jesus to Bless it, to take my brokenness, and unite it with his broken body, so that it may be given, to bless others. May this year of the Eucharist bless your lives, and may you give blessings to others.
