Blessed Broken Given

I received my first communion when I was seven years old, in the second grade. I received communion every Sunday and on weekdays when I was an Altar server. I gave it all the reverence I was instructed to, receiving on my hand putting it in my mouth and making the sign of the cross, then it was changed to bowing before receiving and not making the sign of the cross. Adoration was only done after Mass on Holy Thursday, but I was never catechized in it. I was in my junior year of college when I attended a Youth 2000 retreat, it was a movement to bring young adults to Eucharistic Adoration, when I attended Eucharistic Adoration for the first time. It was there that the Eucharist was really explained to me and the reality of receiving the real body and blood of Christ was revealed to me.

It was a movement that still is moving through the Church today. Shortly after that weekend, my home parish, Holy Family in Peoria opened a perpetual adoration chapel. Eucharistic Adoration was offered at the Newman Center at ISU. Every summer mission trip with high school students had an evening of adoration. Every National Catholic Youth Conference, and training conference for youth ministers had perpetual adoration. The teens at St. Joseph parish in Bradley started a meet up for an hour of adoration, followed by going to IHOP afterwards.

The Eucharist is now one of my favorite topics to talk about. It has become so fascinating to me that Jesus wants to be present to us in this way, and that throughout all of scripture, it points to this reality. Every mass, and time spend in adoration has become more special to me, and has made me hunger for more time with God.




