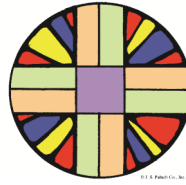

## Introductory Message from our new Pastor, Fr. Brad Baker

(Offered at all Masses the weekend of July 1-2)

I am very grateful for the opportunity to serve as Pastor of Holy Family. But this is not the first time I have had the privilege of being part of the Holy Family Parish community. 58 years ago, my late parents, Babe and Dick Baker, brought me as an infant to be baptized at Holy Family. At that time, the Parish was located not in Shorewood, but on Larkin Avenue, and Fr. Dicken was the priest that baptized me.

Although I have no memory of my baptism outside of a photograph, I do have memories of attending Mass at Holy Family as a young child. By the time I started attending CCD (Religious Education) classes though, our family had joined St. Jude Parish on McDonough Street, where I received my additional Sacraments of Initiation.

Unless you are baptized as an adult, you do not have a choice regarding your parish or the Faith Tradition in which you are formed; my parents made that choice for me. But now, as an adult, and as a priest of 23 years, I want you to know that I requested, I chose to come to Holy Family at this moment in my priesthood. This is the first time in my 23 years of priesthood that I have requested an assignment. Of course, my desire to serve at Holy Family means nothing without the approval of Bishop Hicks and the Personnel Board, and for their approval, I am grateful.

As a native of Joliet, and having had the blessing of serving as a priest for 13 years at the Cathedral of St. Raymond, I consider it a real privilege to return to the people of this area, and to this parish in particular; a real full circle moment for my priesthood.

This assignment also gifts me with close proximity to my younger brother, Todd, and my nephew and niece, Bryan and Brianna, as well as, an abundance of friends. Family and friends are critical to the health and well-being of a priest, and I am richly blessed in that respect.

I am what they refer to as a second career priest, having been ordained at the age of 35. I attribute my priestly vocation to the witness of the Carmelites while I was a student at Joliet Catholic, and to my late parents. The faith of my parents, and their lived experience of the importance and power of a Church community, left an indelible impression on me.

In time, as your Pastor, I hope you will be able to recognize how much I value "faith in action", which is our mission and responsibility as baptized believers in the person of Jesus Christ. And I pray you will also recognize how much I regard the importance of community in our Parish family.

My parents were advocates and instruments of both of those values. We need only remember that the early Church first met in households, not in Churches. It was in those Church households of faith that our Catholic beliefs took root and spread building up the kingdom of God among us.

I recently completed my pastorate at Saints Peter and Paul Parish in Naperville, so that I could have the opportunity to serve at Holy Family. One of the gifts you receive when departing a parish is to receive notes from the Grade School and Religious Education students of the Parish. I want to share two brief excerpts from the many notes I received from the children:

Anna wrote, "Thank you so much for your time here at Saints Peter and Paul. All the years you have been here have been so special. I really enjoy listening to your homilies. You really don't understand how much you have helped me grow in my faith." And Gemma wrote, "You are so sweet and you will have a great time retiring."

Obviously, Gemma misunderstood why I was departing Saints Peter and Paul. And although I am **not retiring**, if it is God's will, it is certainly my prayer and hope that I can serve the Holy Family Parish community until I do retire.

I look forward to the opportunity to know you, and to learn your traditions and way of being Church. Together, let us continue to do our part as Holy Family to build up God's kingdom among us. I assure you of my prayers, and I ask for your prayers and support.

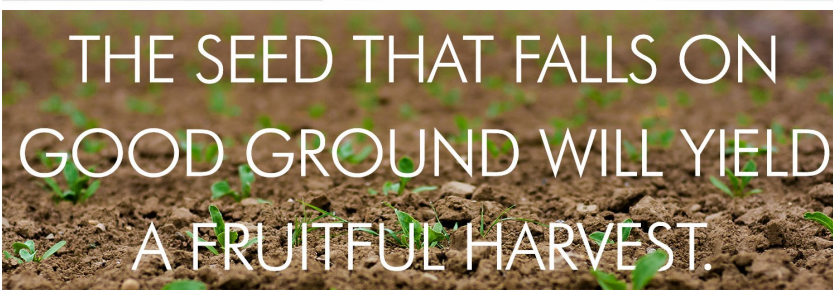
