At least one of the engaged persons (or their parents) must be a registered and active parishioner of Holy Family. Weddings are not scheduled on Saturday evenings or Sundays.

What is Little Flowers Girls Club?

Little Flowers Girls' Club® is a Catholic club for girls in 1st - 6th grade that teaches virtues through scripture, saints' biographies and the Catechism of the Catholic Church. It is based on the 1906 Catholic classic The Catholic Girls' Guide by Fr. F.X. Lasance, and the spirituality of St. Thérése, the Little Flower.

Like a scouting program, girls earn badges for the virtues they practice, which are life skills they are learning. But unlike most scouting organizations, the girls learn and earn their badges through a distinctly Catholic lens. The goal of this program is to dive deeper into the richness of our faith and grow in holiness and devotion, all while having fun and developing friendships.


