Nourished by God's Word & Sacrament, as one family, we are called upon to share our faith in Jesus Christ & reach out to those in need.



### **Holy Water**

By now you have probably noticed that our Holy Water fonts have been restored and reinstalled in our Church. Holy water is a powerful sign of God's grace and protection for Catholics.

Since the beginning of creation, God has used water to bring salvation to his people. We hear how he created the seas and the life within them. He led his chosen people Israel through the Red Sea to save them from Pharaoh and the Egyptians. John the Baptist baptized with water for repentance. Jesus himself, in being baptized, instituted the Sacrament of Baptism, by which we are given new life and made members of Christ's body, the Church. We should never take our baptism for granted!

Holy Water is thus a powerful reminder of our baptism. In making the sign of the cross with Holy Water, we invoke God's protection and ask for his grace. In sprinkling it in our homes, we ask that the Holy Spirit will keep us safe from all bodily and spiritual harm and protect us in times of temptation.

God, in his goodness and mercy, extends his blessings through such signs such as water to those living in a state of grace, nourished by the sacraments of the Church. All this reminds us of the great gift God has given us in baptism. We are made a new creation, and we become children of God, called to live in the freedom from sin that he promises and desires for us.





September 7, 14, 21,28 October 5 and 12 7-8:30 pm in the Joseph room Hosted by David Fiday.


