The forty hours of Eucharistic Adoration Devotion went very well. We appreciate everyone who spent a few minutes, an hour and several hours in prayer with our Lord. If you hunger for the Eucharist outside of the Mass, we offer Eucharistic adoration on the First, Second and Third Thursdays of Each Month. The First and Third Thursdays are 5:00-7:30 PM with Reconciliation from 6:00-7:00 PM. On the Second Thursday Adoration is 7:00-8:30 PM with Praise and Worship, and assisted Intercessory Prayer. During this year of the Eucharist, we encourage and welcome everyone to come and worship and open yourself to and encounter with Christ. God has commanded rest to spend time with him to live life to the full.

Sacrament of Baptism

Sacrament of Marriage

Arrangement must be made through the Parish Office at least 6 months prior to the date requested. Please do not reserve a hall or make other preparations before confirming the date with the Pastor. At least one of the engaged persons (or their parents) must be a registered and active parishioner of Holy Family. Weddings are not scheduled on Saturday evenings or Sundays.




All Saints Day
