### The Year Of The Eucharist



Reverence at Mass, and reverence of the Eucharist are talked about a lot because Christ is truly present in the Bread and Wine which become his body and blood. There is much care and time placed into treating the Eucharist with much dignity to appropriately welcome God in our presence.

I bring this up because I recently found a box of abandoned bibles. These bibles were muddled together haphazardly in a box and stored away. Our Lord is present in the word of sacred scripture, and because he is, we ought to treat our bibles with the reverence and dignity that they deserve as well. The liturgy of the Eucharist is the high point of the mass, but the mass is also made up of the liturgy of the word as well. Christ is present and we ought to give as much dignity to the word as we do for the Eucharist.

Before the gospel is read we all make the sign of the cross on our forehead, lips and heart, and silently pray, May the Word of the Lord be on my mind, on my lips, and in my heart After the Gospel, the priest reverences the lectionary with a kiss. The lectionary is placed on the ambo, a prominent place worthy of the sacred word. Likewise, in our homes, and classrooms we ought to treat our bibles with dignity, put them in a prominent place. If we keep a bible on a shelf or table, we should not stack anything else on top of it. Lastly the best way we can show reverence for the word of God is to read our bibles, reflect on what we've read, and pray about what we read. Let reverence for God the son flow through you in how you receive his word, and his body and blood.


