The Ministries Of Holy Family Parish High School Youth Ministry

God loves teenagers, and teenagers desire to be a part of something where they can learn about faith, grow as a person and enjoy the company of their peers. At Holy Family we accompany students on

their faith journey throughout their high school years. It includes opportunities to explore the big questions in life, encounter God, and grow in faith, within a community of their peers and caring adults. Youth Ministry is not a class, not for the perfect, and not for a particular "type" of teen. Youth Ministry is a spiritual, social and service oriented ministry for teens who want to thrive, but sometime struggle, are caring, but sometimes too much, and want to know God is real.

Youth Ministry is for High School aged students who attend a public, a private high school, or are home schooled. All teens who have completed their sacraments of initiation, and those who are ready to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and First Communion. Even if someone is not Catholic, and not planning to become Catholic, but would like to spend their time with us, are welcome as well.

Any High School aged teen who would like to receive any or all of the sacraments of Catholic Initiation; Baptism, First Eucharist, and Confirmation can do so through this ministry. They will participate in Youth Alpha video and discussion series, followed by sessions on prayer, scripture, sacraments, and morality. There will be a one day annual retreat, and an opportunity for a summer mission trip, and the biennial National Catholic Youth Conference.






