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## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- Families are required to be registered parishioners of St. Elizabeth Seton or obtain a letter of permission from their parish in order for the baptism to take place at Seton.
- It is traditional in the church to present the presiding priest/deacon with a stipend. The stipend is normally presented after the ritual has been concluded and presented to the presider through the Godfather / Godparent. The recommended stipend is \$25.00.

## **GODPARENT INFORMATION**

- Traditionally a Godfather and a Godmother are chosen for a child. At least one is required to be Catholic.
- Catholic Godparents must be baptized, confirmed and at least 16 years of age. If he or she is married, they must be married according to the laws of the Catholic Church.
- Catholic Godparents must contact the parish *in which they are registered* to obtain a Sponsor Certificate. The Sponsor Certificate should state that the Godparent is a registered and active member of the Parish and is qualified to act as a Godparent. A hardcopy of the certificate is preferred, but a fax will be accepted if it is time sensitive. The Sponsor Certificate should also be sent to Sue Iffert's attention at St. Elizabeth Seton, 10655 Haverstick Road, Carmel, IN 46033.
