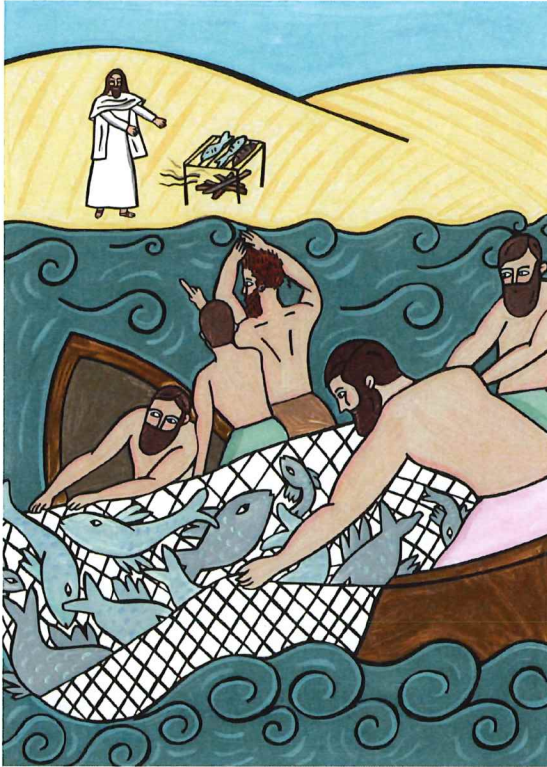

Sunday, May 4, 2025
Do You Love Him?



Today's readings: Acts 5:27–32, 40b–41; Psalm 30:2, 4, 5–6, 11–12, 13; Revelation 5:11–14; John 21:1–19 or John 21:1–14. Today, we hear about Jesus revealing himself to his disciples for a third time after the resurrection. He shows up on an average day, as the disciples do their work. They are struggling to catch fish, and he directs them to cast their net on the right side of the boat. After they do so, they are unable to pull the net because of the number of fish they have caught. So Jesus is recognized: “It is the Lord.” He invites them to break bread with him.

When they finish their breakfast, Jesus asks Peter: “Simon, son of John, do you love me more than these?”

Peter replies with a resounding “Yes, Lord, you know that I love you.” Jesus asks the same question twice more, perhaps because Peter denied him three times during the passion. Each time Peter replies yes, Jesus instructs the disciple to feed or tend the Lord’s sheep.

It is a blessing to reflect on the many ways Jesus appears to us. We know he is present in the Word and in the Eucharist, but today we are reminded that he also appears to us in ordinary ways. When he appears to you in your day-to-day routines and asks you if you love him, what do you say to him? Is your response timid or resounding? How do you feed his lambs or tend his sheep?



THIS WEEK AT HOME

Monday, May 5

Food for Eternal Life

Jesus tells the crowd searching for him in Capernaum that they should “not work for food that perishes but for the food that endures for eternal life.” Consider what you dedicate yourself to throughout the day. Do you spend your time focusing on earthly desires? What inspires you to say yes to the Lord? Why do you choose to follow him? This evening, spend time praying about your relationship with God. Ask for the strength to set your focus on “the food that endures for eternal life.” *Today’s readings: Acts 6:8–15; Psalm 119:23–24, 26–27, 29–30; John 6:22–29.*

Tuesday, May 6

When Preaching Is Challenging

Stephen concludes his discourse angrily, calling out those around him as “stiff-necked” and opposing the Spirit. The people Stephen addresses are infuriated and begin to stone him. Stephen, “filled with the Holy Spirit,” is given the strength he needs to face his martyrdom. Reflect on times you have struggled to preach the Gospel. What has been challenging for you? Ask for the strength to wholeheartedly follow the Lord. *Today’s readings: Acts 7:51–8:1a; Psalm 31:3cd–4, 6 and 7b and 8a, 17 and 21ab; John 6:30–35.*

Wednesday, May 7

There Was Great Joy

After Stephen is martyred, “a severe persecution of the Church in Jerusalem” broke out. Those who followed Jesus were “scattered throughout the countryside” and “went about preaching the word.” We are told that Philip goes to Samaria to preach the Word. Despite being persecuted, the crowds experience great joy because of Philip’s ministry. When you are persecuted or put down by life’s struggles, to whom or to what do you turn for “great joy”? *Today’s readings: Acts 8:1b–8; Psalm 66:1–3a, 4–5, 6–7a; John 6:35–40.*

Thursday, May 8

Called to Serve

In today’s first reading, from Acts, an angel of the Lord and the Spirit guide Philip to minister to an Ethiopian court official. Philip proclaims Jesus to him by explaining Scripture and baptizing him. When have you felt called to serve someone else? Ask God for the wisdom to hear and the courage to respond when you are being called to serve another. *Today’s readings: Acts 8:26–40; Psalm 66:8–9, 16–17, 20; John 6:44–51.*

Friday, May 9

Instruments

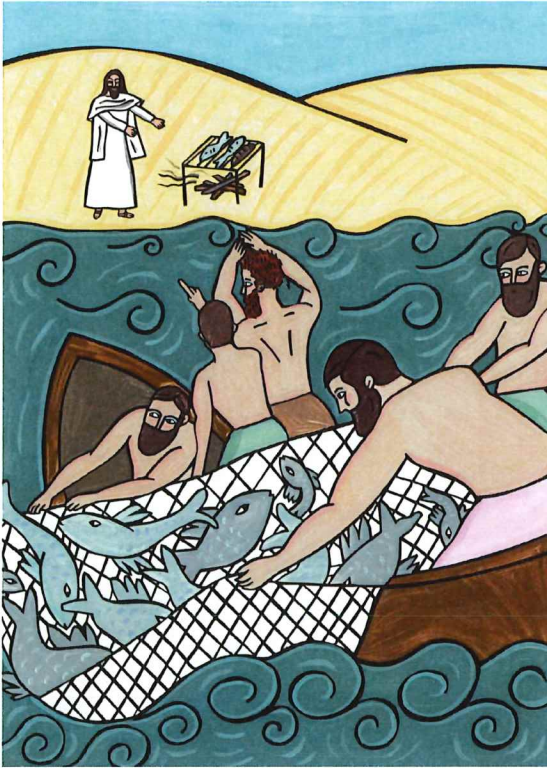
Today’s first reading begins with Saul “still breathing murderous threats” against the disciples. Despite the atrocities Saul has committed, the Lord describes him to Ananias as “a chosen instrument.” Saul is eventually baptized and proclaims that Jesus is the Son of God in the synagogues. We believe in a God who can do all things! Today, say a prayer for someone who is working against God. Kindly lift them up and ask God to be with them. *Today’s readings: Acts 9:1–20; Psalm 117:1bc, 2; John 6:52–59.*

Saturday, May 10

St. John of Avila

St. John of Avila was born in the Castile region of Spain. He studied law, philosophy, and theology before he was ordained a diocesan priest. He inherited his parents’ fortune and chose to distribute the inheritance to the poor. John came to be known as a great preacher and spiritual director, unafraid of denouncing evil. To celebrate his feast day, say a prayer in gratitude for the gifts (spiritual, financial, professional, and practical) that you have inherited from previous generations. How can you share your inheritance? *Today’s readings: Acts 9:31–42; Psalm 116:12–13, 14–15, 16–17; John 6:60–69.*

¿Lo amas?



Lecturas del día: Hechos 5:27–32, 40b–41; Salmo 30:2, 4, 5–6, 11–12, 13; Apocalipsis 5:11–14; Juan 21:1–19 o bien Juan 21:1–14. Escuchamos que Jesús se revela ante sus discípulos por tercera vez después de la resurrección. Aparece en un día normal, cuando los discípulos están trabajando. Tienen dificultad para pescar y él les indica que lancen la red al lado derecho de la barca. Lo hacen y capturan tal cantidad de peces que no pueden tirar de la red. Y así reconocen a Jesús: “Es el Señor”. Él los invita a partir el pan con él.

Habiendo desayunado, Jesús pregunta a Pedro: “Simón, hijo de Juan, ¿me amas más que éstos?”. Pedro responde, “Sí,

Señor, tú sabes que te amo”. Jesús le repite la pregunta dos veces, tal vez porque Pedro lo negó tres veces durante la Pasión. Cada vez que Pedro responde sí, Jesús instruye al discípulo a alimentar o a cuidar las ovejas del Señor.

Es una bendición meditar en las muchas maneras en que Jesús se nos aparece. Aunque sabemos que él está presente en la Palabra y en la Eucaristía, hoy recordamos que también se nos aparece en lo ordinario. Cuando Jesús se le aparece en su día a día y le pregunta si usted lo ama, ¿qué le dice? ¿Su respuesta es tímida o rotunda? ¿Cómo alimenta o cuida usted a sus corderos?



ESTA SEMANA EN CASA

Lunes, 5 de mayo

Alimento para vida eterna

Jesús dice a la multitud que lo busca en Cafarnaúm, “No trabajen por el pan que perece, sino por el pan que perdura para vida eterna”. Considere a qué dedica usted su día. ¿Usted se la pasa enfocándose en deseos terrenales? ¿Qué le inspira a decir “sí” al Señor? ¿Por qué decide usted seguirlo? Esta noche, dedique tiempo a orar por su relación con Dios. Pida fuerza para centrarse en el alimento que permanece para vida eterna. *Lecturas del día: Hechos 6:8–15; Salmo 119:23–24, 26–27, 29–30; Juan 6:22–29.*

Martes, 6 de mayo

Predicar es un desafío

Esteban cierra su discurso enojado, califica a quienes lo rodean “de dura cerviz” y opuestos al Espíritu. Los aludidos se enfurecen y comienzan a apedrearlo. Esteban, “lleno del Espíritu Santo”, recibe la fuerza necesaria para afrontar su martirio. Reflexione en las ocasiones en las que ha tenido dificultades para predicar el Evangelio. ¿A qué desafíos se han enfrentado? Pida fuerzas para seguir al Señor de todo corazón. *Lecturas del día: Hechos 7:51–8:1a; Salmo 31:3cd–4, 6 y 7b y 8a, 17 y 21ab; Juan 6:30–35.*

Miércoles, 7 de mayo

Había una gran alegría

Martirizado Esteban, estalló “una severa persecución contra la Iglesia en Jerusalén”. Los que seguían a Jesús se “dispersaron por la región” e “iban predicando la palabra”. Se nos dice que Felipe va a Samaría a predicar la palabra. Incluso perseguidas, las multitudes experimentan gran gozo por el ministerio de Felipe. Cuando usted es perseguido o abatido por las luchas de la vida, ¿a quién o a qué acude usted en busca de “gran gozo”? *Lecturas del día: Hechos 8:1b–8; Salmo 66:1–3a, 4–5, 6–7a; Juan 6:35–40.*

Jueves, 8 de mayo

Llamados a servir

En el pasaje de Hechos, un ángel del Señor y el Espíritu guían a Felipe para ministrar a un funcionario de la corte etíope. Felipe le anuncia a Jesús explicándole las Escrituras y lo bautiza. ¿Cuándo se ha sentido usted llamado a servir a alguien? Pida a Dios sabiduría para escuchar y coraje para responder cuando sea llamado a servir a otro. *Lecturas del día: Hechos 8:26–40; Salmo 66:8–9, 16–17, 20; Juan 6:44–51.*

Viernes, 9 de mayo

Instrumentos

La lectura comienza con Saulo “todavía respirando amenazas de muerte” contra los discípulos. A pesar de las atrocidades cometidas por Saulo, el Señor se lo describe a Ananías como “un instrumento elegido”. Saulo finalmente es bautizado y proclama que Jesús es el Hijo de Dios en las sinagogas. ¡Creemos en un Dios que puede hacerlo todo! Hoy, ore por quienes trabajan en contra de Dios. Por favor, colóquelos en su oración y pídale a Dios que esté con ellos. *Lecturas del día: Hechos 9:1–20; Salmo 117:1bc, 2; Juan 6:52–59.*

Sábado, 10 de mayo

San Juan de Ávila

San Juan nació de Ávila, en la región de Castilla, España. Estudió derecho, filosofía y teología antes de ser ordenado sacerdote diocesano. Heredó la gran fortuna de sus padres y decidió distribuir la herencia entre los pobres. Juan fue reconocido como un gran predicador y director espiritual, sin miedo a denunciar el mal. Para celebrar su fiesta, rece una oración en gratitud por los dones (espirituales, económicos, profesionales) que usted ha heredado de generaciones anteriores. ¿Cómo comparte usted su herencia? *Lecturas del día: Hechos 9:31–42; Salmo 116:12–13, 14–15, 16–17; Juan 6:60–69.*
