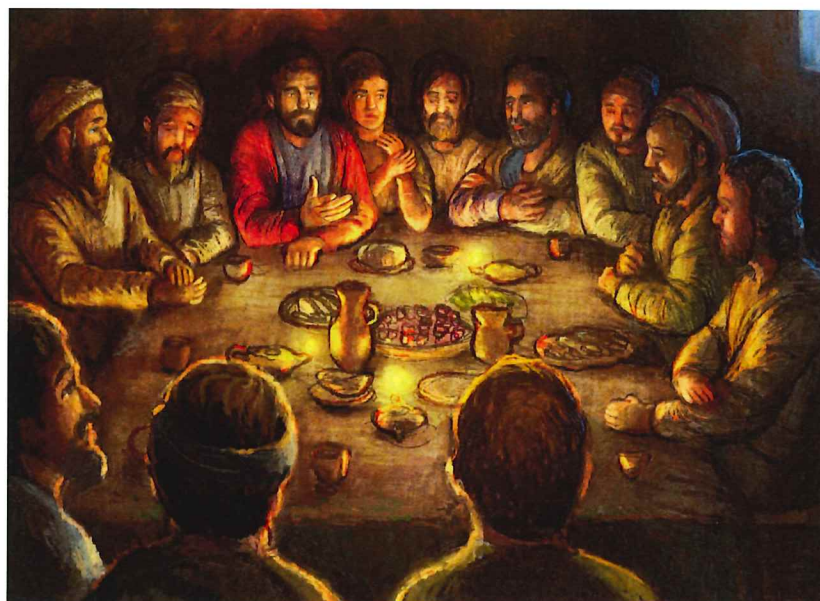

Sunday, May 25, 2025

The Guiding Spirit



Today's readings: Acts 15:1–2, 22–29; Psalm 67:2–3, 5, 6, 8; Revelation 21:10–14, 22–23; John 14:23–29. Next week, we will celebrate the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. This week, we hear Jesus remind the disciples that he will be “going away,” or ascending. He tells them that, even though he is joining the Father, he is with them: “The Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you.” The Holy Spirit is with us, too, inspiring us as we discern how to best respond to the call to be followers of Christ.

As the Easter season nears its end, prayerfully reflect on the ways the Holy Spirit has guided you. Begin your

reflection by invoking the Holy Spirit. (“Come, Holy Spirit.”) Light a candle, if possible. Where can you see God moving in your life? Consider the following: various settings that have moved or inspired you; conversations with friends or family that have helped clarify something for you; a passing thought or feeling that has resurfaced. Next, ask for the wisdom to respond!

The apostles were sent to pastorally respond to the needs of various communities. How have you been asked to respond to the needs around you? End your prayer by reading the Gospel passage. Sit with Jesus’ words: “Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you.”



THIS WEEK AT HOME

Monday, May 26

St. Philip Neri

St. Philip Neri, the founder of a religious community of priests and lay brothers called the Oratory, was known for his humor and holiness. Look back on your day. Did you greet others joyfully? Did you cheerfully fulfill your responsibilities? Pray for the ability to find joy in your daily tasks. Ask St. Philip Neri to pray for you! *Today's readings: Acts 16:11–15; Psalm 149:1b–2, 3–4, 5–6a and 9b; John 15:26–16:4a.*

Tuesday, May 27

St. Augustine of Canterbury

Augustine was known as the “apostle of England.” He led monks from Rome to England to evangelize the Anglo-Saxons. As they journeyed to England, they heard stories that instilled fear in them; Augustine was filled with doubt about the mission and returned to Rome. Pope Gregory the Great reassured them, and they set out again for England. When have you doubted your abilities? Ask God for the confidence you need to respond to him. *Today's readings: Acts 16:22–34; Psalm 138:1–2ab, 2cde–3, 7c–8; John 16:5–11.*

Wednesday, May 28

Truth

Jesus tells his disciples that “the Spirit of truth . . . will guide you to all truth.” We know that the Spirit reveals the truth of God’s glory to us. If possible, attend daily Mass. *Today's readings: Acts 17:15, 22–18:1; Psalm 148:1–2, 11–12, 13, 14; John 16:12–15.*

Thursday, May 29

The Ascension

At Mass, we participate in the paschal mystery and are called to share the news of the miraculous events we witness. God accompanies us as we preach “in his name.” The Holy Spirit

strengthens us to joyfully accept the difficult yet transformative call to be followers of Christ. *Today's readings: Acts 1:1–11; Psalm 47:2–3, 6–7, 8–9; Ephesians 1:17–23 or Hebrews 9:24–28; 10:19–23; Luke 24: 46–53.*

Thursday, May 29

St. Paul VI

In 1958, Pope John XXIII named Fr. Giovanni Battista Montini a cardinal. As cardinal, he helped prepare the Second Vatican Council. He was elected pope in June 1963. Pope Paul VI continued the Council, which reformed and renewed the Church. The Second Vatican Council called for the faithful’s full and active participation in the liturgy. What does that mean to you? *Today's readings: Acts 18:1–8; Psalm 98:1, 2–3ab, 3cd–4; John 16:16–20.*

Friday, May 30

Laboring

Jesus tells his disciples that pain, weeping, and grieving will precede their joy. He likens the Christian journey to a woman in labor: she is first “in anguish because her hour has arrived,” but then she “no longer remembers the pain because of her joy” once the child is born. This evening, hand your hardships and labor over to God. *Today's readings: Acts 18:9–18; Psalm 47:2–3, 4–5, 6–7; John 16:20–23.*

Saturday, May 31

The Visitation

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. When Mary learns that her cousin Elizabeth is also pregnant, she travels to visit her. Upon hearing Mary, Elizabeth’s baby leaps inside her womb and Elizabeth joyfully exclaims the joy of Mary as the mother of the Lord. Who has celebrated joyous moments with you? Pray in gratitude for the ways they have accompanied you through growth and celebration. *Today's readings: Zephaniah 3:14–18a or Romans 12:9–16; Isaiah 12:2–3, 4bcd, 5–6; Luke 1:39–56.*

La guía del Espíritu



Lecturas del día: Hechos 15:1–2, 22–29; Salmo 67:2–3, 5, 6, 8; Apocalipsis 21:10–14, 22–23; Juan 14:23–29. La próxima semana celebramos la Solemnidad de la Ascensión del Señor. Esta semana escuchamos a Jesús recordar a sus discípulos que “se irá” o ascenderá. Añade que, aunque se una al Padre, estará con ellos el “Consolador, el Espíritu Santo, que el Padre enviará en mi nombre, les enseñará todo y les recordará todo lo que les he dicho”. El Espíritu Santo también está con nosotros, inspirándonos a discernir cómo responder mejor al llamado de seguir a Cristo.

Conforme se termina el tiempo de Pascua, medite cómo el Espíritu Santo lo ha guiado. Comience la reflexión invocando al Espíritu Santo. (“Ven, Espíritu Santo”).

Encienda una vela, si es posible. Pida la gracia de recordar estas últimas cinco semanas. ¿Dónde percibe usted la presencia de Dios en su vida? Considere varios escenarios que lo han conmovido o inspirado, conversaciones con amigos o familiares que le han ayudado a aclarar algo, un pensamiento pasajero o un sentimiento. A continuación, ¡pida sabiduría para responder!

Los apóstoles fueron enviados para responder pastoralmente a las necesidades de diversas comunidades. ¿Cómo se le ha pedido responder a las necesidades de su entorno? Termine su oración leyendo el pasaje del Evangelio. Quédese con las palabras de Jesús: “La paz les dejo; mi paz les doy”.

San Felipe Neri

Agustín conducía a monjes desde Roma a Inglaterra para evangelizar a los anglosajones. En el trayecto escucharon historias que les infundieron miedo; Agustín dudó de la misión y regresó a Roma. El papa Gregorio Magno los reconfortó y partieron de nuevo hacia Inglaterra. ¿Cuándo ha dudado de sus capacidades? Pida a Dios la confianza y la tenacidad necesarias para responderle. *Lecturas del día: Hechos 16:22–34; Salmo 138:1–2ab, 2cde–3, 7c–8; Juan 16:5–11.*

Miércoles, 28 de mayo

La verdad

Jesús promete a sus discípulos que “el Espíritu de verdad... lo guiará a la verdad completa”. Sabemos que el Espíritu nos revela la verdad de la gloria de Dios. Si es posible, vaya a misa cada día de esta semana. Es allí donde encontraremos más plenamente la verdad que se halla en la Palabra de Dios y en la Eucaristía. *Lecturas del día: Hechos 17:15, 22–18:1; Salmo 148:1–2, 11–12, 13, 14; Juan 16:12–15.*

Jueves, 29 de mayo

La Ascensión

En misa, participamos del misterio pascual y se nos invita a llevar la Buena Nueva del milagroso evento que testificamos. Dios nos acompaña cuando predicamos “en su nombre”. El

Espíritu Santo nos fortalece para aceptar con gozo las dificultades de ser discípulos eficaces de Cristo. Pida sabiduría para percibir al Espíritu Santo actuando en usted. *Lecturas del día: Hechos 1:1–11; Salmo 47:2–3, 6–7, 8–9; Efesios 1:17–23 o bien Hebreos 9:24–28; 10:19–23; Lucas 24: 46–53.*

Jueves, 29 de mayo

San Pablo VI

En 1958, el papa Juan XXIII nombró al P. Giovanni Battista Montini, cardenal. En esa función, él ayudó a preparar el Concilio Vaticano II. Elegido Papa en junio de 1963, Pablo VI continuó el Concilio que reformó y renovó la Iglesia. El Concilio Vaticano II pidió la participación plena y activa de los fieles en la liturgia. ¿Qué significa eso para usted? *Lecturas del día: Hechos 18:1–8; Salmo 98:1, 2–3ab, 3cd–4; Juan 16:16–20.*

Viernes, 30 de mayo

Laborando

Jesús anuncia a sus discípulos que el dolor, el llanto y la tristeza precederán al gozo. Él compara el camino de la fe con una mujer en labores de parto: primero está “angustiada porque ha llegado su hora”, pero cuando nace el niño, “ya no recuerda el dolor a causa de su alegría”. Esta noche recupere la paz sabiendo el gozo inimaginable que experimenta cuando está con Dios. *Lecturas del día: Hechos 18:9–18; Salmo 47:2–3, 4–5, 6–7; Juan 16:20–23.*

Sábado, 31 de mayo

La Visitación

Celebramos la Fiesta de la Visitación de la Santísima Virgen María. María se entera de que su parienta Isabel también está embarazada, y viaja a visitarla. Cuando escucha a María, el bebé de Isabel le salta en el vientre, e Isabel grita gozosa la gracia de María como madre del Señor. ¿Quién ha celebrado momentos felices con usted?
