Sunday, June 8, 2025

Receive the Spirit



Today's readings: Acts 2:1–11; Psalm 104:1, 24, 29–30, 31, 34; 1 Corinthians 12:3b–7, 12–13 or Romans 8:8–17; John 14:15–16, 23b–26 or John 20:19–23. In the Gospel from John 20, we hear that the disciples had locked themselves up, for fear of those who were persecuting Jesus' followers. After Jesus' crucifixion, the disciples were lost, unsure of what to do next. Despite the locked doors, Jesus appears to them and says: "Peace be with you." They rejoice when they see his wounds, indeed confirming what Mary Magdalene announced to them: "I have seen the Lord" (20:18, just prior to today's reading). Jesus sends the disciples out, breathing on them: "Receive the holy Spirit." After receiving the

Spirit, the disciples have the courage to come out of hiding; they understand their mission to share the Good News and are equipped with what they need to do so.

The Solemnity of Pentecost celebrates God's sending of the Holy Spirit upon Jesus' disciples after his resurrection. This solemnity marks the end of the Easter season. On this day, we are reminded to call on the Holy Spirit every day. The Holy Spirit emboldens us to respond to our call to go out and share the truth of life after death in Christ. Let us pray for a deeper indwelling of the Holy Spirit, that we may receive the courage, wisdom, and patience needed to listen to the ways God moves in our lives.



THIS WEEK AND BEYOND

Monday, June 9

Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church

The Memorial of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church, is celebrated the Monday after Pentecost. Mary has the title “Mother of the Church” because she gave birth to Jesus, who is the Head of the Church. This evening, pray the Rosary or the Magnificat. Ask Mary to intercede for you. *Today’s readings: Genesis 3:9–15, 20 or Acts 1:12–14; Psalm 87:1–2, 3 and 5, 6–7; John 19:25–34.*

Monday, July 14

St. Kateri Tekakwitha

St. Kateri is the first North American native to be canonized. When she was four, her family died during a smallpox epidemic; she was left disfigured and half blind. Kateri was adopted by an uncle who did not approve of her interest in Catholicism, but she still converted to the faith at age nineteen. To celebrate St. Kateri, spend time learning about her dedication to her faith. How can you be a witness to her example? *Today’s readings: Exodus 1:8–14, 22; Psalm 50:8–9, 16bc–17, 21 and 23; Matthew 10:34–11:1.*

Tuesday, July 22

St. Mary Magdalene

St. Mary Magdalene, one of Jesus’ disciples, accompanied the Lord in his darkest time, during his crucifixion. Mary Magdalene was one of the witnesses chosen to announce the resurrection to the apostles; because of this, she is known as the “apostle to the apostles.” Today, prayerfully read John 20:1–2, 11–18. How are you, like Mary Magdalene, a witness to the resurrection of our Savior? How can you tell others that you have “seen the Lord?” *Today’s readings: Song of Songs 3:1–4b or 2 Corinthians 5:14–17; Psalm 63:2, 3–4, 5–6, 8–9; John 20:1–2, 11–18.*

Tuesday, July 29

Martha, Mary, and Lazarus

Jesus visits Martha and Mary after Lazarus, their brother, died. Martha and Mary, at different times in John 11, approach Jesus and say to him: “Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died.” Later in John 11, we read that Jesus weeps when he sees Lazarus’ body. Jesus weeps with us in our times of grief and sadness. This evening, learn about Ignatian contemplation, also known as imaginative prayer or Gospel contemplation. After learning about this form of prayer, practice it while reading of the raising of Lazarus (John 11:1–44). *Today’s readings: Exodus 33:7–11, 34:5b–9; Psalm 34:2–3, 4–5, 6–7, 8–9, 10–11; John 11:19–27.*

Friday, August 8

St. Dominic

St. Dominic, a Spanish priest, was known for his preaching. He founded the Order of Preachers, also known as the Dominicans. The Dominicans follow four pillars: prayer, study, community, and preaching. After Dominic’s example, they dedicate themselves to balancing these four pillars in their lives to proclaim the Good News. How can you dedicate yourself to prayerfully study your faith? Consider joining a Bible study at a parish near you. *Today’s readings: Deuteronomy 4:32–40; Psalm 96:1–2a, 2b–3, 7–8a, 10; Matthew 16:24–28.*

Wednesday, August 27

St. Monica

Monica was St. Augustine of Hippo’s mother. Most of what we know about her comes from Augustine’s writings. In his *Confessions*, Augustine describes himself as a wayward son. St. Monica had a vision that assured her he would return to the faith, so she dedicated herself to praying and fasting for him. St. Monica teaches us the importance of patient, disciplined prayer. Today, ask St. Monica to join you as you bring your intentions to God. *Today’s readings: 1 Thessalonians 2:9–13; Psalm 131:1bcde, 2, 3; Matthew 23:27–32.*

Domingo, 8 de junio de 2025

Recibir al Espíritu



Lecturas del día: Hechos 2:1–11; Salmo 104:1, 24, 29–30, 31, 34; 1 Corintios 12:3b–7, 12–13 o bien Romanos 8:8–17; Juan 14:15–16, 23b–26 o bien Juan 20:19–23. Los discípulos se habían encerrado en una habitación, temerosos de quienes los perseguían a causa de sumarse a Jesús. Allí, a puertas cerradas, Jesús se les aparece, se pone en medio de ellos y les dice: “La paz esté con ustedes”. Se alegran al verle las llagas que confirma lo anunciado por María Magdalena: “He visto al Señor” (20:18, justo antes de la lectura de hoy). Jesús envía a los discípulos, soplando sobre ellos: “Reciban el Espíritu Santo”. Después de recibir el

Espíritu, los discípulos tienen el valor de salir de su escondite; entienden su misión de compartir la Buena Nueva y están equipados con lo que necesitan para hacerlo.

La solemnidad de Pentecostés celebra el envío del Espíritu Santo por parte de Dios sobre los discípulos de Jesús. Esta solemnidad marca el final del tiempo pascual. En este día, se nos recuerda que debemos invocar al Espíritu Santo todos los días, no sólo en este domingo. Oremos por una morada más profunda del Espíritu Santo, para que recibamos el coraje, la sabiduría y la paciencia necesarios para escuchar las formas en que Dios se mueve en nuestra vida.



ESTA SEMANA Y DESPUÉS

Lunes, 9 de junio

Madre de la Iglesia

El lunes posterior a Pentecostés celebramos la memoria de la Bienaventurada Virgen María, Madre de la Iglesia. María tiene el título de “Madre de la Iglesia” porque dio a luz a Jesús, Cabeza de la Iglesia. Esta noche, rece el Rosario o el Magníficat. Pida a María que interceda por usted. *Lecturas del día: Genesis 3:9–15, 20 o bien Hechos 1:12–14; Salmo 87:1–2, 3 y 5, 6–7; Juan 19:25–34.*

Lunes, 14 de julio

Santa Kateri Tekakwitha

La primera nativa norteamericana en ser canonizada es santa Kateri. Tenía cuatro años cuando su familia murió durante una epidemia de viruela; ella quedó desfigurada y medio ciega. Kateri fue adoptada por un tío que se oponía al interés de ella por el catolicismo; aun así, ella se convirtió a la fe a los diecinueve años. Para celebrar a la santa, aprenda sobre su dedicación a su fe. ¿Cómo puede usted ser testigo de su ejemplo? *Lecturas del día: Éxodo 1:8–14, 22; Salmo 50:8–9, 16bc–17, 21 y 23; Mateo 10:34–11:1.*

Martes, 22 de julio

Santa María Magdalena

Santa María Magdalena, una de las discípulas de Jesús, acompañó al Señor en su momento más oscuro, durante su crucifixión. Fue una de las elegidas para anunciar la resurrección a los apóstoles; por eso se le conoce como la “apóstola de los apóstoles”. Hoy, lea en oración Juan 20:1–2, 11–18. ¿Es usted, como lo fue María Magdalena, testigo de la resurrección de nuestro Redentor? ¿Cómo puede asegurar a los demás haber “visto al Señor”? *Lecturas del día: Cantar de los Cantares 3:1–4b o bien 2 Corintios 5:14–17; Salmo 63:2, 3–4, 5–6, 8–9; Juan 20:1–2, 11–18.*

Martes, 29 de julio

Marta, María y Lázaro

Jesús visita a Marta y María después de la muerte de Lázaro, hermano de ellas. Marta y María, en distintos momentos, se acercan a Jesús y le dicen: “Señor, si hubieras estado aquí, mi hermano no habría muerto”. Jesús llora cuando va a la tumba de Lázaro. Jesús llora con nosotros en nuestros tiempos de dolor y tristeza. Indague la contemplación ignaciana, conocida como oración imaginativa o contemplación del evangelio. Luego, practíquela mientras lee el relato de la resurrección de Lázaro (Juan 11:1–44). *Lecturas del día: Éxodo 33:7–11, 34:5b–9; Salmo 34:2–3, 4–5, 6–7, 8–9, 10–11; Juan 11:19–27.*

Viernes, 8 de agosto

Santo Domingo

Santo Domingo era un gran predicador. Fundó la Orden de Predicadores, o dominicos. Los dominicos tienen cuatro pilares: oración, estudio, comunidad y predicación. Se dedican a equilibrar estos cuatro pilares en sus vidas para proclamar la Buena Nueva. ¿Cómo puede usted dedicarse a estudiar su fe con oración? Considere unirse al estudio bíblico de una parroquia cercana. *Lecturas del día: Deuteronomio 4:32–40; Salmo 96:1–2a, 2b–3, 7–8a, 10; Mateo 16:24–28.*

Miércoles, 27 de agosto

Santa Mónica

Mónica fue la madre de san Agustín de Hipona. En sus *Confesiones*, Agustín se describe como un hijo descarriado. Santa Mónica tuvo una visión que le aseguraba que él volvería a la fe, por lo que se dedicó a orar y ayunar por él. Santa Mónica nos enseña la importancia de la oración paciente y disciplinada. Aunque es posible que nuestras oraciones no sean respondidas ni al instante ni de la manera esperada, sabemos que Dios escucha atentamente nuestras peticiones. Hoy, pida a santa Mónica que esté con usted mientras le presenta sus intenciones a Dios. *Lecturas del día: 1 Tesalonicenses 2:9–13; Salmo 131:1bcde, 2, 3; Mateo 23:27–32.*

THIS IS THE LETTER I WROTE to Father Ron,

Dear Ron,

After 16 marvelous years here at St. Anne Parish, as Faith Formation Director and an active parishioner, I am full of gratitude for the many blessings I've received. I also am grateful for each person, young and old, who has helped me grow in meaningful relationships, in service to our God, with others, in prayer and community building.

Thank you, Fr Ron, for your leadership and for trusting me with ideas and efforts in building the community of God's people. I've loved it all.

Now, the Holy Spirit is guiding me on a different direction of the same journey, walking with God's people. I am being called to walk with my sisters in our Holy Names of Jesus and Mary community in Campbell, California.
