The Second Sunday of Advent

"Produce good fruit as evidence of your change of heart."

Matthew 3:8



Dear Friends,

Here in the second week of Advent, Isaiah hands us a beautiful vision: wolves and lambs hanging out like they are old friends, a child leads wild animals, and a world governed by someone who actually ‘gets it’—someone who doesn’t judge by appearances, self-interest or power, but by justice, mercy, commitment to the poor and spirit-filled wisdom.

Maybe it’s me, but it’s hard not to notice how politically charged that vision is. It is not partisan but deeply political. Isaiah is not imagining a cozy Christmas card. He is describing a world reordered from the ground up. It is a world where the poor are not merely an afterthought. Where the rich and powerful don’t devour the weak. Where leaders don’t put on a performance but take time to listen. Where justice flowers in community not from fear but from kindness. This is the kind of world for which we all ache though it seems far away.

In the Gospel of Matthew, John the Baptizer appears out of the desert wild and unfiltered. His food and clothing link him with Samson, Samuel, and Elijah who represent a tradition of resistance to injustice and a revolutionary model for renewing society. John is not interested in “business as usual.” John challenges everyone but his sharpest critiques are aimed at the wealthy elites. He is not just focused on personal peccadillos rather he is looking for real change that shakes social systems and hearts alike.

“...Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight the paths,” means, stop normalizing lies and corruption. Stop pretending that dishonesty and injustice are inevitable. Stop calling broken structures “just the way it is.” Stop remaining blind and silent to society’s sins. Advent is not just about passively waiting for some far-off future. It is actively preparing for the world to change. That kind of transformation calls for conversion, repentance, reform, social change, revolution and the radical transformation of the human condition. Jesus’ transfiguration and resurrection are symbols of the change for which we long; a world and humanity illuminated from within with the glory of God.

In The letter to the Romans, Paul reminds us that God’s plan is communal and universal. It is not tribal, never nationalistic, never about insiders vs. outsiders. Jews and Gentiles, us and them, all are invited, all are welcomed. All are part of God’s wide, mercy-shaped kingdom. This is a direct challenge to every political vision that narrows our compassion or draws small circles around those who “count.”

Our readings today are clear about the kind of world God wants; leaders who defend the poor; Systems that don’t crush the vulnerable; communities that choose peace over fear; politics shaped by truth not marketing; people whose hearts and vision stretch wider than their borders. During Advent God whispers to us, *“Yes, the world is broken. But don’t get used to that. I am doing something new.”* God uses us to prepare the way—in our hearts, in our communities, and even our political imaginations. Maybe Advent is asking us not to prepare for a holy day but to prepare for a holy world. We refuse to accept that the world can’t change.

Because according to Isaiah... it can. According to the Baptizer...it must. According to Christ...it will.

El Segundo Domingo de Adviento

"Produzcan frutos buenos como prueba de su cambio de corazón."

Mateo 3,8



Queridos Amigos,

Aquí, en la segunda semana de Adviento, Isaías nos ofrece una visión hermosa: lobos y corderos pasando el rato como viejos amigos, un niño guiando a animales salvajes y un mundo gobernado por alguien que realmente “lo entiende”: alguien que no juzga por apariencias, interés propio o poder, sino por justicia, misericordia, compromiso con los pobres y una sabiduría llena del espíritu.

Quizá sea cosa mía, pero es difícil no notar lo cargada de sentido político que está esta visión. No es partidista, pero sí profundamente política. Isaías no está imaginando una tarjeta navideña acogedora. Está describiendo un mundo reordenado desde sus cimientos. Es un mundo donde los pobres no son simplemente un pensamiento tardío. Donde los ricos y poderosos no devoran a los débiles. Donde los líderes no se limitan a actuar una interpretación, sino que se toman tiempo para escuchar. Donde la justicia florece en la comunidad no por miedo, sino por bondad. Este es el tipo de mundo por el que todos suspiramos, aunque parezca lejano.

En el Evangelio de Mateo, Juan el Bautista aparece desde el desierto, salvaje y sin filtros. Su comida y vestimenta lo vinculan con Sansón, Samuel y Elías, quienes representan una tradición de resistencia a la injusticia y un modelo revolucionario para renovar la sociedad. Juan no está interesado en “lo de siempre.” Juan desafía a todos, pero sus críticas más agudas van dirigidas a las élites adineradas. No se enfoca únicamente en faltas personales; busca un cambio real que sacuda tanto los sistemas sociales como los corazones.

“...Preparen el camino del Señor, enderecen sus senderos,” significa: dejen de normalizar la mentira y la corrupción. Dejen de fingir que la deshonestidad y la injusticia son inevitables. Dejen de llamar “así son las cosas” a estructuras rotas. Dejen de permanecer ciegos y silenciosos ante los pecados de la sociedad. Adviento no es solo esperar pasivamente un futuro lejano. Es preparar activamente la transformación del mundo. Ese tipo de transformación exige conversión, arrepentimiento, reforma, cambio social, revolución y una transformación radical de la condición humana. La transfiguración y la resurrección de Jesús son símbolos del cambio que anhelamos: un mundo y una humanidad iluminados desde dentro por la gloria de Dios.

En la carta a los Romanos, Pablo nos recuerda que el plan de Dios es comunitario y universal. No es tribal, nunca nacionalista, nunca sobre “los de adentro” contra “los de afuera.” Judíos y gentiles, nosotros y ellos, todos están invitados, todos son bienvenidos. Todos forman parte del amplio reino de Dios moldeado por la misericordia. Esto desafía directamente cualquier visión política que limite nuestra compasión o trace círculos estrechos alrededor de quienes “cuentan.”

Nuestras lecturas de hoy son claras acerca del tipo de mundo que Dios desea: líderes que defiendan a los pobres; sistemas que no aplasten a los vulnerables; comunidades que elijan la paz en lugar del miedo; una política moldeada por la verdad y no por el mercadeo; personas cuyos corazones y visión se extiendan más allá de sus fronteras. Durante el Adviento, Dios nos susurra: *“Sí, el mundo está roto. Pero no te acostumbres a eso. Estoy haciendo algo nuevo.”* Dios nos usa para preparar el camino—en nuestros corazones, en nuestras comunidades e incluso en nuestra imaginación política. Tal vez el Adviento nos pida no prepararnos para un día santo, sino para un mundo santo. Nos negamos a aceptar que el mundo no puede cambiar.

Porque, según Isaías... puede. Según el Bautista... debe. Según Cristo... cambiará.

All of creation is crying out for peace: from children affected by mass shootings at schools; to extractive mining in Latin America; to the violent cycles of militarism, racism, and poverty— all of these examples are void of any vision for the common good. We may very much feel like John the Baptist in today's Gospel —a voice of one crying out in the desert"— while we are inspired by Romans 8 "waiting with eager expectation" to be "set free from slavery to corruption" (v. 19, 21).

Pope Leo XIV tells us that "Nonviolence, as a method and a style, must distinguish our decisions, our relationships and our actions." May Gospel Nonviolence, as an individual and collective anecdote to the fractured relationships in our world, be the driving force to restore, repair, and promote a just and lasting peace. As our prayer today, I invite us to listen to "Wage Peace" by Lori True and pray the question: What would it mean to "wage peace with our breath, wage healing with our touch and wage compassion with our eyes" this Advent? - Michelle Sherman - Creation Awaits

Como oración para hoy, los invito a escuchar "Wage Peace" de Lori True y a rezar con la pregunta: ¿Qué significaría "forjar la paz con nuestra respiración, sanar con nuestro toque y ofrecer compasión con nuestros ojos" este Adviento?
