

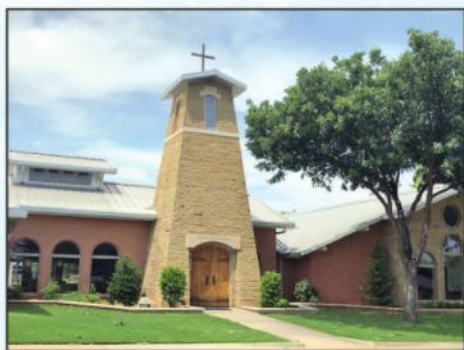

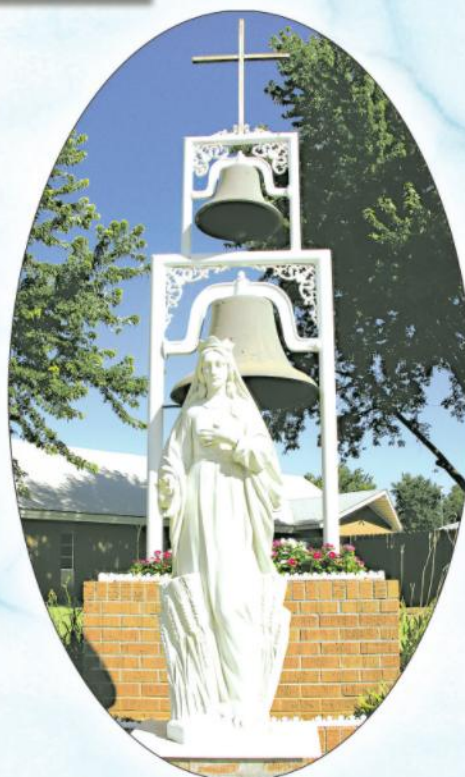

Guide Us To Thy Perfect Light

Sunday Theme

The Greek word Epiphany (*επιφάνεια*), means *appearance* or *manifestation*.

First, the angels revealed Jesus to the shepherds.

In the Western Church, the Feast of the Epiphany

celebrates Jesus' first appearance to the Gentiles, represented by the Magi,

while in the Eastern Church,

the feast is the commemoration of the baptism of Christ where the Father and the Holy Spirit gave combined testimony to Jesus' identity as Son of God.

Later, in the synagogue at Nazareth,

Jesus revealed himself as the promised Messiah,

and at Cana he revealed his Divinity

by transforming water into wine.

These multiple revelations are all suggested

by the Feast of the Epiphany.



La palabra griega Epiphany (*επιφάνεια*), significa *aparición* o *manifestación*.

Primero, los ángeles revelaron a Jesús a los pastores.

En la Iglesia occidental,

la fiesta de la Epifanía

celebra la primera aparición de Jesús ante los gentiles,

representado por los Reyes Magos,

mientras que en la Iglesia Oriental,

la fiesta es la conmemoración del bautismo de Cristo donde el Padre y el Espíritu Santo dieron un testimonio combinado de la identidad de Jesús como Hijo de Dios.

Más tarde, en la sinagoga de Nazaret,

Jesús se reveló como el Mesías,

prometido, y en Caná reveló su Divinidad

transformando el agua en vino.

Estas múltiples revelaciones se sugieren

por la fiesta de la Epifanía.

From the Pastor's Desk

Today's Gospel teaches us how Christ enriches those who bring him their hearts.

The adoration of the Magi fulfills the oracle of Isaiah, prophesying that the nations of the world would travel

to the Holy City following a brilliant light, bringing gold and incense to contribute to the worship of God.

Today's Responsorial Psalm includes a verse about kings coming from foreign lands to pay homage to a just king in Israel.

Paul's letter to the Church of Ephesus, expresses God's secret plan in clear terms: "*the Gentiles are...copartners in the promise in Christ Jesus through the Gospel.*"

Today's Gospel reminds us that if God permitted the Magi – foreigners and pagans – to recognize and give Jesus proper respect as the King of Jews, we should know that there is nothing in our sinful lives that would keep God from bringing us to Jesus.

There were three groups of people who reacted to the Epiphany of Christ's birth.

The first group, headed by King Herod, tried to eliminate him,

the second group, priests and scribes, ignored him, and the third group,

represented by the shepherds and the Magi, came to adore him.



El Evangelio de hoy nos enseña cómo Cristo enriquece a los que le traen sus corazones.

La adoración de los Reyes Magos cumple el oráculo de Isaías, profetizando que las naciones del mundo viajarían a la Ciudad Santa siguiendo una luz brillante, traer oro e incienso para contribuir a la adoración de Dios.

El Salmo Responsorial de hoy incluye un verso sobre los reyes que vienen de tierras extranjeras para rendir homenaje a un rey justo en Israel.

Carta de Pablo a la Iglesia de Efeso, expresa el plan secreto de Dios en términos claros: "*Los gentiles son... copartners en la promesa en Cristo Jesús a través del Evangelio.*"

El Evangelio de hoy nos recuerda que si Dios permitió que los Reyes Magos –extranjeros y paganos– reconocieran y dar a Jesús el debido respeto como el Rey de los Judíos, debemos saber que no hay nada en nuestra vida pecaminosa que impediría que Dios nos llevara a Jesús.

Hubo tres grupos de personas que reaccionaron a la Epifanía del nacimiento de Cristo.

El primer grupo, encabezado por el rey Herodes, trató de eliminarlo,

el segundo grupo, sacerdotes y escribas, lo ignoró, y el tercer grupo,

representado por los pastores y los Reyes Magos, vino a adorarlo.
