From The Pastor's Desk

Today we are asked to think about invitations. At times, we greet invitations with mixed reactions. First, we consider who sent us the invitation. Was it someone we know well or perhaps just a person we've only met few times? Do they really want us to come, or are they just trying to fill up their guest list? When we are thinking about how we should respond, I would guess most of us would base our reply on who invited us. We're more likely to say yes to an invitation if we have a good relationship with the one who has invited us, or if we want to further a relationship we have with a certain person.

Today's readings overflow with images of abundance and of a wonderful banquet. The one who is inviting is none other than God. And you and I are the invited guests at this *never-to-be-imagined* feast. Life is basically an invitation from God. He invites to feast now and to continue that feasting into eternity. Life itself is the basic invitation. And within that larger invitation there are thousands and thousands of smaller invitations. Our task is to recognize the invitations from God, and give our reply with the way we shape our lives.

It seems to me that many times we go through life, we see God's image. It may be a situation, a person, an event. And within that invitation is always to a fuller life. Even if, at times, it's painful to respond to God's call, the final outcome is always more life for us. We grow through saying, 'yes', over and over again to the many thousands of invitation that each of us will receive during our lifetime. Each time we say 'yes' to one of God's invitations, we are allowing the image of Christ to shine through us in a little brighter way. Hopefully, one day we will be able to say with St. Paul, that it is no longer I that live, but Christ who lives in me.

Besides considering how to respond to the invitation of God, we must also look at the one who does the inviting. Our Scripture readings today extol the unfathomable generosity of God. We are given pictures of nothing less than the most magnificent of feasts. And these wonderful offerings of the best foods and drinks are all for us.



Watch, O Lord, with those who wake, or watch, or weep tonight, and give your angels and saints charge over those who sleep.

Tend Your sick ones, O Lord Christ.

Rest Your weary ones.

Bless Your dying ones.

Soothe Your suffering ones.

Pity Your afflicted ones.

Shield Your joyous ones, and all for Your love's sake.








Our Faith... Our Future
