From The Pastor's Desk

The theme of freedom is one that we must never tire of talking or thinking about. It is at the heart of the Gospel message, and of the will of God for all of us. In today's Gospel passage, Luke presents Jesus as one who has come to free us. Jesus proclaims before the people: He has sent me to bring tidings to the poor, to proclaim liberty to captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free...God is freedom itself, and God's wish is that we become as free as we can possibly be.

What does it mean to be free? It doesn't mean that we can do anything we want. That is not freedom. That would only be a recipe for chaos. When people do whatever they want and do not have any regard for the rights of other people, then we have destruction and dictatorship. Freedom is the ability to be whom God wants us to be – loving and caring and peaceful human beings.

In a negative sense, freedom means that we are not the slaves of anything or anyone. Sometimes, we are slaves to our past. Sometimes, we are slaves to a routine. Sometimes, we are slaves to one way of looking at life. We are often slaves to things or even to people.

Many people become trapped by their own past, maybe they had drifted away from living the kind of life that they wanted to, and became involved in situations that now bring them nothing but regret. They allow this dark side of their life to overshadow them and find themselves haunted by images of how they used to be. This can be a real form of slavery. This is one form of slavery that Jesus clearly wants to free us from. For a Christian, there should be no doubt that forgiveness is the great gift that is available to all of us. Forgiveness of our sins is meant to free us from our past. It enables us to put away those times in our lives when we may have been enslaved to a sinful way of thinking and acting. Forgiveness frees us to begin again – to make a clean break with the knowledge that the Lord forgets our sins. Imagine your sins as if they were a large rock. God takes that rock and throws it into the deepest part of the ocean where it is never seen nor thought about ever again.

Jesus wants to free us, not only from our sins, but from any form of oppression – whether that oppression comes from without ourselves or from within. It seems that the process of liberation often involves a crisis of some sort. And sometimes, grace comes disguised as a crisis. What at first may look like a disaster in our lives can, at times, lead to a greater personal freedom. I'm not implying in the least that this is an easy process, or one that we can always see with great clarity. When we first experience some crisis it may seem like our world has come to an end. We can't see any way out. It is at that time we need to allow God to come into our lives in an even greater way. We need to allow God to work within those difficult times, so that he can lead us through the darkness into the light.
