## From The Pastor's Desk

Jesus speaks directly to our hearts when he urges us with these words: *Give and gifts will be given to you.*

Compassion requires a use of our God-given imagination. Our imagination helps us to get out of ourselves. It enables us to see and experience situations that may not be a part of our present lives, but which make up a large part of other people's lives. For example, you may not be blind, but if you allow your imagination to work for you, you can get some sense of what it must mean to be blind. You could read about blindness and imagine what it would be like if you were blind; or you could talk to a blind person and listen to his or her experience of blindness and so enter, at least partially, into the world of that other person. That is really one of the keys to compassion – entering the world of another – walking a mile in someone else's shoes. But this requires openness to the experience of other people. If I am a closed person, then compassion will not be able to live within my spirit because I will not be able to enter into anyone else's lived experience. Then the hungry and the hurting will not affect me at all. In my mind I will push them away, afraid to feel anything of their pain and distress. This leads to coldness and distance in ourselves.

Where is the call of Christ for compassion today? For the hungry and emotionally ill; for the sick and the aging; for the jobless and homeless; for the outcasts of our society; for the illegal aliens fleeing dangers in their countries; for those close to us who need our affection and attention; for those who suffer from a deep sense of isolation. I encourage you to make your own list – to examine where in your lives you see the need for more compassion on your part.

Our Scriptures today emphasize the importance of loving our enemies – really loving them. This means very concretely not wanting revenge for wrongs that have been inflicted on us. Not wishing harm on others. They call us to go out of our way to show love for others. *Pray for those who treat you badly.* After all, don't they need your prayers as much, if not more than others?

When we give, forgive, have mercy, then in a marvelous and mysterious way, we become like God, for we are then taking to heart Jesus' words: *Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful.*

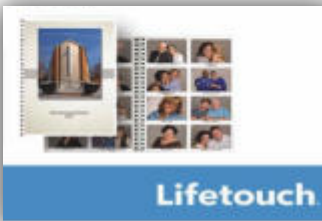
