From The Pastor's Desk

So where do you keep your old love letters? Are they tied up with a pretty ribbon and hidden in a box under the bed? Or maybe they are lying somewhere in the back of your closet under a pile of old books. But more important than where you keep them, why are you keeping them? All of those old letters and card that meant so much to you when you first received them - aren't they just so much history now, just fond memories of the past? Why are you having so much trouble throwing them out?

You say you're not quite sure why you're hanging on to them? Well, let me guess. Those old letters and card are such beautiful reminders of some of the best times in your life that you think if you throw them away, you are denying that those times existed at all. You would be denying wonderful love you experienced, a love that told you that life was worth living and that you were worthy of life. By the way, if you don't have any old love letters, maybe it's time to start writing some!

Love letters are beautiful things. But don't worry if you don't have any hidden under your bed, because we all have a very large and beautiful love letter from God - we call it the Holy Scriptures, The Bible, The Word of God. And today, the only thing I want to do is remind you of that love letter and encourage you to look at it once again.

Our love letters from those who have loved us and do love us are like anchors in the sea of life, if I may be allowed to use an overworked and somewhat simple image. As we sail through life in our little boats, sometimes this sea gets so rough that we need to get into a place of shelter and throw the anchor out for a while so that we can regain a sense of security. True human love can give us that feeling of not being lost and alone. God has given us to one another and told us that the best thing we can do is to bring our love to each other.

As we read those old love letters, we once again are able to picture our beloved. Their words bring them alive to us once more, and so it is with reading the Sacred Scriptures. We hear how God took care of the chosen people - how God continually sheltered them, forgave them, consoled them, and finally how God sent Jesus as the Word Made Flesh, so that we could see how great God's love for us really is.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us that, "The Church forcefully and specifically exhorts all the Christian faithful...to learn the surpassing knowledge of Jesus Christ, by frequent reading of the divine Scriptures." [par. 133]

So how are we supposed to do this reading and reflecting on the Scriptures? There are many different ways, but let me suggest one way. A very simple and effective way is to take the Scripture readings for the coming Sunday, and allow those readings to be part of our prayer during the week. What really matters is to allow God's Word to slowly become a part of your thinking, breathing and living. God's love letter can change our lives as it has done for so many people since the days when Jesus walked on earth.



- **Altar Server Ministry:** A very special way to serve God for the youth (at least 10 years old) and adults to help the Priest and Deacon during mass and special ceremonies
- Extra Ordinary (Eucharistic) Ministry: What a blessing to be an Eucharistic Minister for He has chosen you to be in the presence of 'BODY and BLOOD OF CHRIST". Couples and teenagers (16 and over who are in religious education classes) are encouraged to serve.
- **Funeral Ministry:** An opportunity to help people at the moment of their greatest need for assistance and comfort.


