





**WOMEN'S DISCERNMENT GROUP:** All women 19-35 are invited to join the Women's Discernment Group for Vocations to Religious Life! The invitation to this Women's Discernment Group is by no means meant to place any unnecessary pressure on a woman, no matter where she is in her season of discernment. This is merely an invitation to gather *together* - to enter into deep conversation, grow in authentic sisterhood, and allow for authentic discernment of God's will and desire for your life to unfold. Whether you feel the call to religious life very strongly and have heard the Lord's still, small voice asking you to consider loving Him in a very unique way, or there is just a little part of your heart that desires something about religious life, but you just want to explore from afar, or if you're somewhere in the middle, this Discernment Group is for you.

Know that you are not alone in your discernment and that there are others who feel the same things you feel, fear the same things you fear, and desire the same things you desire. Sometimes our potential call to religious life can be bogged down by the noise and busy-ness of this world, and we feel as if we don't know which way to go. This Discernment Group has grown out of the desire to bring women together and provide a space for deep prayer, deep conversation, deep friendship, and authentic discernment.



We will begin in October, reading Mother Clare Matthias' book 'Discerning Religious Life' together, over the course of a 16-week period! **DAILY MASS GOERS:** Beginning Monday Sept. 07, I will be praying Morning or Evening prayer fifteen minutes prior to the start of daily Mass. Morning prayer and Evening prayer are called the two hinges of prayer. Every priest and consecrated person is obliged to pray this prayer and every lay person is strongly encouraged and should be taught. This is my introduction for you. Morning prayer will occur on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday; evening prayer on Wednesday. (This will not interfere with the Novena). One catch, you will need an Iphone or tablet to pray! Once, the disciples asked Jesus to teach them to pray and he taught them the Our Father; today we an Iphone or tablet!

**iBreviary TS Plus** is the name of the app we will be using. It is available for free download in the App Store. I've included some screen shots so that you can be sure that you are downloading the correct app. Once you have the app downloaded, you can find the daily prayers by selecting "Pray!" in the top left hand corner of the home page. Father will explain further how to use the app. iBreviary will also allow you to follow the readings for Mass.

On the first Friday of the month we have Mass at 7pm followed by Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. I will not have evening prayer from iBreviary.

On every other Friday, i.e. Mass in the morning will have a time of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. I will invite some of the children from Annunciation School to spend some time in the Church.
