- CYM meets on Wednesdays at 7:30 pm at SMC.

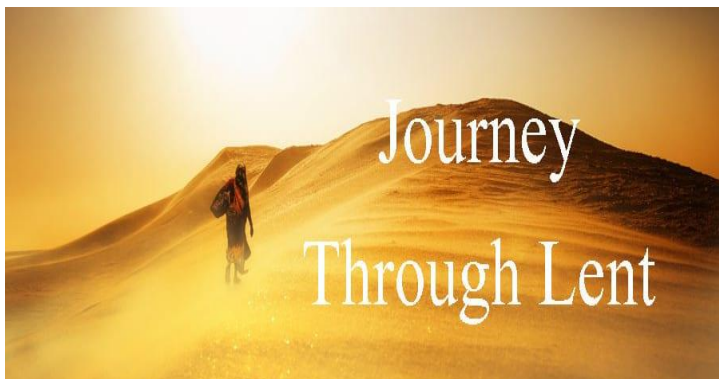


Sick List
