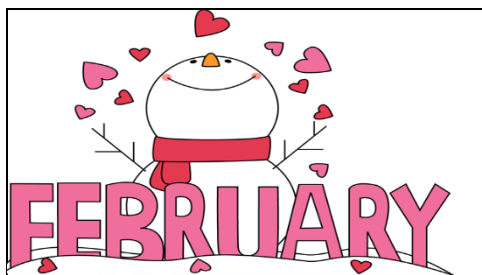
- **Anointing and Blessing of the Sick** will be every first Friday of each month at the 8:00 am Mass.
