Try to wait a few weeks until things settle down. If you need to go to confession now, I will be in the parking lot on Saturdays from 11-12 and 3-3:45. Please stay in your car. Wait at the entrance to the confession zone (a line of cones). When I'm available, drive up carefully. I will stay about ten feet away from you. The next person in line should stay

two hundred feet away at the cone entrance. If it's raining, I'll be at the canopy entrance.

If you or your loved one is in danger of death, please call for the anointing of the sick. If it isn't urgent, then please try to wait until restrictions are reduced.

Parish Mailing and Phone Calls

We will likely send out a mailing to the whole parish within a week or two with important updates because some of our parishioners don't use computers.

We have started making phone calls to parishioners to let them know what is going on and ask how they're doing.

and neighbors—especially those not on social media or e-mail.

Holy Week—Live Streamed but not Recorded

Our schedule is a little different during the holiest week of the year. This year is going to be different because of the coronavirus.

The Vatican issued directives in light of the coronavirus. Our bishop then sent them to us priests. We can live stream the liturgies but not record them.

Events outside of Holy Week are being live streamed and recorded. For Holy Week, we invite you to join us at the scheduled times.

Palm Sunday—Live Streamed but not Recorded

We celebrate the Passion of the Lord at Mass this Palm Sunday. We'll hear the Passion according to St. Matthew.

Palm will not be blessed today. We'll store it and bless it at a time when it can be distributed.

As with other Sundays, we'll start the Rosary at 9 AM and Mass at 9:20 AM.

Chrism Mass

The bishop will celebrate the Chrism Mass at a later date.

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday of Holy Week

The 8 AM Mass will be live streamed but not recorded.

Holy Thursday—7 PM Mass of the Lord's Supper

The washing of feet will be omitted. The usual procession with the Blessed Sacrament will be omitted. The Blessed Sacrament will be kept in the tabernacle.

Good Friday—3 PM Service

A special coronavirus intention will be included.

Holy Saturday—8 PM Easter Vigil

The preparation and lighting of the fire will be omitted. The Paschal Candle will be lit without a procession. Baptismal promises will be renewed but no one will receive sacraments. RCIA candidates will hopefully be able to receive sacraments as early as Pentecost.

Easter Sunday—9 AM Rosary and 9:20 AM Mass

Mass will be live streamed but not recorded. Join us live.

As of March 27th, I haven't decided what other services to do such as Morning Prayer, Stations of the Cross, and Holy Hours. See Flocknote, the website, or YouTube for updates.

Reading of the Passion

When I was a teenager and young adult, I was always the narrator on Good Friday. I remember really entering into the mystery of Christ's cross. You could hear a pin drop in the church. As a priest, I read the part of Jesus. It was only then that I started thinking of people rejecting me like they rejected Jesus. It wasn't just me entering into a scene and marveling what Jesus did for us. It's now my entering into the scene and being called to be like Jesus, to take up my cross and follow Him.

This coronavirus is a new cross for us. Many of us are bystanders, watching as others carry heavy crosses. Some of us are carrying heavy crosses. These include health care workers, police, supermarket workers, and pharmacy workers. Some are out of work. Some don't know how they're going to pay the bills. Some are home alone.

It's ok for us to enter into the mystery of this cross. When we do us, we'll encounter Jesus who is right there helping us. We may get glimpses of the resurrection to come. He may give us surprising hope so that we may be beacons to others.


