

Pandemic Liturgical Directives

We have a few upcoming liturgies that you might want to know about.

Presentation of the Lord, February 2nd

We cannot have a procession with lighted candles or distribute blessed candles. I could bless candles that you bring to Mass. (I'm not sure how much of this we've done in past years.)

St. Blaise, February 3rd

We cannot have the individual blessing of throats. The priest will give a general blessing for everyone at the end of Mass on February 3rd and the following weekend.

Ash Wednesday, February 17th

We can distribute ashes at the conclusion of Masses on Ash Wednesday. Q-tips will be used to impose ashes. A new Q-tip will be used for each person.

Mass Intentions

Because of the pandemic we have six Sunday Masses instead of four. And the office is not yet open to the general public. So, we have plenty of openings for Mass intentions.

Normally, we would open the 2022 Mass book in February. However, let's wait until July when we have a better idea of how many Sunday Masses we'll have. Also, we have plenty of openings in the 2021 Mass book.

Room Movement & Upgrades

As I write this on Monday, 1/25, Tom and Matt have already emptied the former priest sacristy in the Parish Center. The Knights of Columbus can now move their materials into it.

Tomorrow, 1/26, Victor Bala will begin packing up the store so that we can move it over to the Parish Center.

Tom will contact our locksmith to rekey some

locks to reflect the new arrangement.

Even though we've just begun the movement, renovations, and upgrades, I'm looking forward to our parish growing again.

Respect Life

We had a larger gathering than usual for our holy hour on Friday, January 22nd. Many parishioners are praying for a greater respect for human life including life in the womb. I was impressed by how much everyone was enraptured by Jesus Christ right there in the monstrance on the altar. Whether very able or barely able, we can all be loved by Jesus and enter into the sacred mysteries. If you are able, please help our less able parishioners and neighbors.
