REFLECTION ON SUNDAY'S READINGS

PERSISTENCE

Exodus recounts the journey of the Israelites out of slavery in Egypt to the land promised to their ancestors. It was not an easy journey. In today's reading, they are attacked by Amalek and his soldiers, members of one of the peoples who live in the land through which the Israelites are traveling. Moses was on the hilltop with his arms raised to invoke the LORD's assistance in the battle below, a powerful illustration of the LORD's favor upon Israel. If the soldiers were to lift up their eyes to that hill (see Psalm 121:1), they would be reassured by Moses's presence and posture. Paul urges the Thessalonians to persist in proclaiming the gospel, and Jesus likewise commends the widow for her persistence in pursuit of the justice due her. Whether they preach or pray, the followers of Jesus need persistence through periods of difficulty.

REFLEXIÓN SOBRE LAS LECTURAS DEL DOMINGO

LA PERSISTENCIA

El libro del Éxodo narra el viaje de los israelitas desde la esclavitud en Egipto hasta la tierra prometida a sus antepasados. No fue un viaje fácil. En la lectura de hoy, son atacados por Amalec y sus soldados, integrantes de uno de los pueblos que habitaba por donde pasaron los israelitas. Moisés estaba en la cima de la montaña con los brazos levantados para invocar la ayuda del Señor en la batalla que estaba ocurriendo colina abajo, un ejemplo poderoso del favor del Señor sobre Israel. Si los soldados estuvieran con sus ojos hacia la colina (ver salmo 121:1), se sentirían tranquilos por la presencia y postura de Moisés. Pablo insta a los tesalonicenses a que perseveren en la proclamación del Evangelio, y Jesús elogia igualmente a la viuda por su persistencia en la búsqueda de la justicia que le corresponde. Ya sea que prediquen u oren, los seguidores de Jesús necesitan de la perseverancia en los períodos de dificultad.

EUCARISTIC REVIVAL

From the 2021 USCCB document on the Eucharist, the doctrinal source text for the Eucharistic Revival, "The Mystery of the Eucharist in the Life of the Church"

Food for the Journey

The lives of the saints and blessed show us the importance of the Eucharist on our journey as disciples of Jesus. Many testify to the power of the Eucharist in their lives. We see the fruits of Holy Communion in their lives of faith, hope, and charity. It was their intimate union with Jesus in Holy Communion and frequently their prayer before the Blessed Sacrament that nourished and strengthened them in their journey to heaven. They teach us that "growth in Christian life needs the nourishment of Eucharistic Communion, the bread for our pilgrimage until the moment of death, when it will be given to us as viaticum." Blessed Carlo Acutis, a young Italian teenager, who died at the age of fifteen and was beatified in 2020, used to say: "The Eucharist is my highway to heaven." Blessed Carlo attained sanctity at such a young age because the Eucharist was at the center of his life. He attended Mass daily and prayed each day before the Blessed Sacrament in adoration. He discovered the joy of friendship with Jesus and brought that joy, the joy of the Gospel, to others. He was an apostle of the Eucharist through the internet. He said: "To always be united with Christ: This is my life's program."

Likewise, St. José Sánchez del Río, a Mexican teenager who was martyred at the age of fourteen and canonized in 2016, was so filled with love of Christ and his Church that he was willing to give up his life rather than renounce Christ and his Kingship. While imprisoned, St. José Sánchez del Río was able to receive the Blessed Sacrament when it was smuggled into his cell along with a basket of food. Strengthened by this viaticum, he was able to endure torture and to remain faithful to Christ when his captors told him he must renounce his faith or be executed. He replied to his persecutors: "My faith is not for sale." We encourage all, especially our young people, to learn about the lives of these holy teenagers. In the midst of many distractions in our life, Blessed Carlo and St. José Sánchez del Río teach us to focus on what is more important than anything else.





BLESSING OF THE ANIMALS --SACRED HEART SCHOOL

On October 4th, Sacred Heart gave a big, warm welcome to Father Ron for the annual Blessing of the Animals. The Blessing of the Animals is a beautiful annual ceremony celebrating the human-animal bond, originating from a Roman Catholic tradition as part of the feast day of St. Francis of Assisi (October 4th), the patron saint of animals and the environment.
