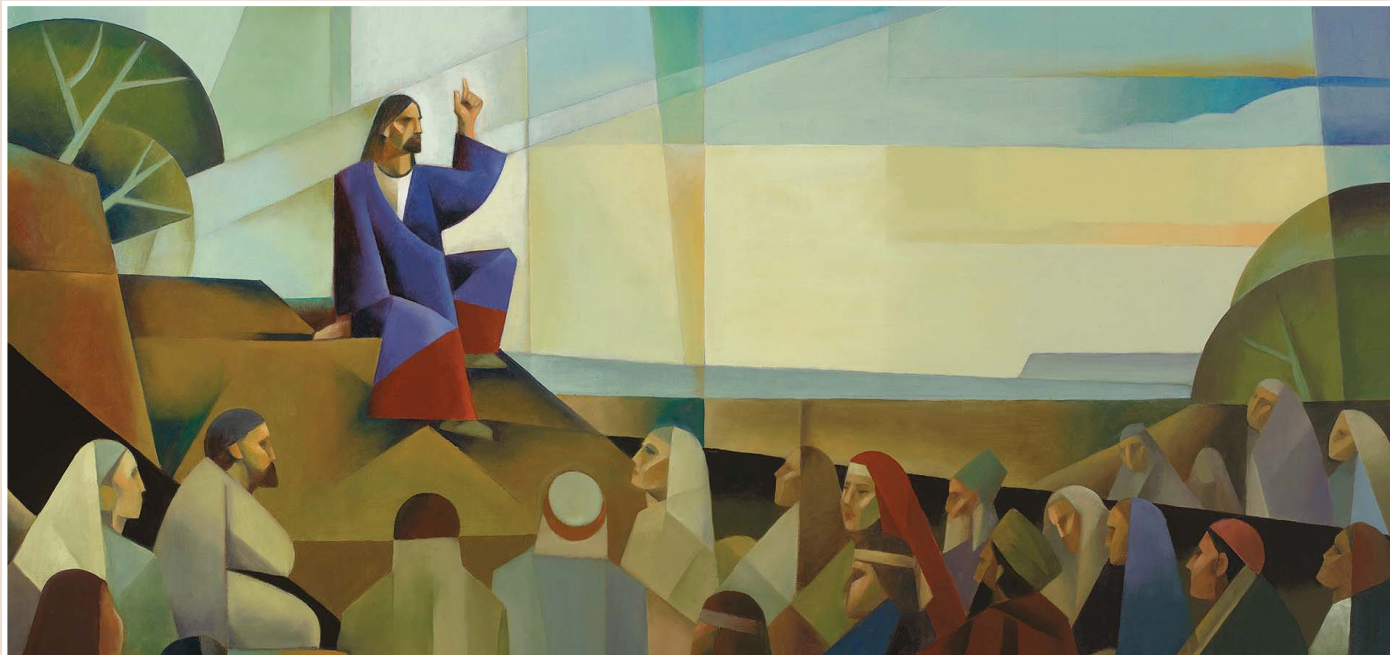

A WORD FROM FATHER KELLY

This week, on Ash Wednesday, we begin our season of Lent. This period of 40 days was originally understood to be the final preparation for the Catechumens, or the Elect, prior to receiving the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist) at the Easter Vigil. Today, Lent is understood as a more formal time of examining how we are living our lives and taking action to move forward in the process of conversion, that is, our turning back to God. There are various ways in which we can make good use of these days. This year I would like to suggest that each of us find a way to use these 40 days to help improve the life of someone around us – charity: to allow God to use us as his instruments to share his love with one in need of that love. For our personal spiritual growth, the following suggestions may be helpful: Ash Wednesday Mass with the distribution of Ashes (note: Ashes will not be distributed outside of our Mass times). We will have bilingual Masses at 7:00 a.m., 12:15 p.m., and 6:00 p.m. Stations of the Cross, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, and Benediction are more traditional practices during the time of Lent and may help us focus our attention. We will pray the Stations of the Cross on the Wednesdays of Lent this year beginning at 6:00 p.m. (these too will be prayed bi-lingually so that everyone can participate – books provided). Following the Stations of the Cross we will have a time of Adoration, guided by a scripture or spiritual reading, and silence and will end with Benediction at 7:00 p.m. Finally, there will be 4 Reconciliation Services in Salinas to which you are invited – all begin at 6:00 p.m.: March 3 at Cristo Rey; March 17 at Madonna del Sasso; March 24 at St. Mary's; and March 31 at Sacred Heart. We will have regular confession time here at Sacred Heart on February 24 and March 10 – there will be no confessions during Holy Week. May these 40 days truly lead us to God.

UNAS PALABRAS DEL PADRE KELLY

Esta semana, el Miércoles de Ceniza, comenzamos nuestra temporada de Cuaresma. Este período de 40 días se entendió originalmente como la preparación final para los catecúmenos, o los elegidos, antes de recibir los sacramentos de iniciación (Bautismo, Confirmación, Eucaristía) en la Vigilia Pascual. Hoy, la Cuaresma se entiende como un tiempo más formal para examinar cómo estamos viviendo nuestras vidas y tomar medidas para avanzar en el proceso de conversión, es decir, nuestro regreso a Dios. Hay varias maneras en que podemos hacer un buen uso de estos días. Este año me gustaría sugerir que cada uno de nosotros encuentre una manera de usar estos 40 días para ayudar a mejorar la vida de alguien que nos rodea - la caridad: permitir que Dios nos use como sus instrumentos para compartir su amor con alguien que necesita ese amor. Para nuestro crecimiento espiritual personal, las siguientes sugerencias pueden ser útiles: Misas del Miércoles de Ceniza con la distribución de Cenizas (nota: Las cenizas no se distribuirán fuera de nuestros horarios de Misa). Tendremos misas bilingües a las 7:00 a.m., 12:15 p.m. y 6:00 p.m. El Vía Crucis, la Adoración del Santísimo Sacramento y la Bendición son prácticas más tradicionales durante el tiempo de Cuaresma y pueden ayudarnos a centrar nuestra atención. Rezaremos el Vía Crucis los miércoles de Cuaresma a partir de las 6:00 p.m. (se rezarán bilingüemente para que todos puedan participar, se proporcionan libros). Después del Vía Crucis tendremos un tiempo de Adoración, guiados por una escritura o lectura espiritual, y silencio y terminaremos con la Bendición a las 7:00 p.m. Finalmente, habrá 4 Servicios de Reconciliación en Salinas a los que está invitado, todos comienzan a las 6:00 p.m.: 3 de marzo en Cristo Rey; 17 de marzo en Madonna del Sasso; 24 de marzo en St. Mary's; y el 31 de marzo en el Sagrado Corazón. Tendremos tiempo regular de confesión aquí en el Sagrado Corazón el 24 de febrero y el 10 de marzo, no habrá confesiones durante la Semana Santa. Que estos 40 días nos lleven verdaderamente a Dios.

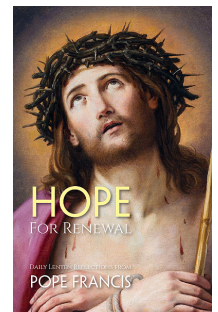

HOSPITALIZED/HOMEBOUND: Please notify the Parish Office if you or someone you know would like to receive the Anointing of the Sick.
