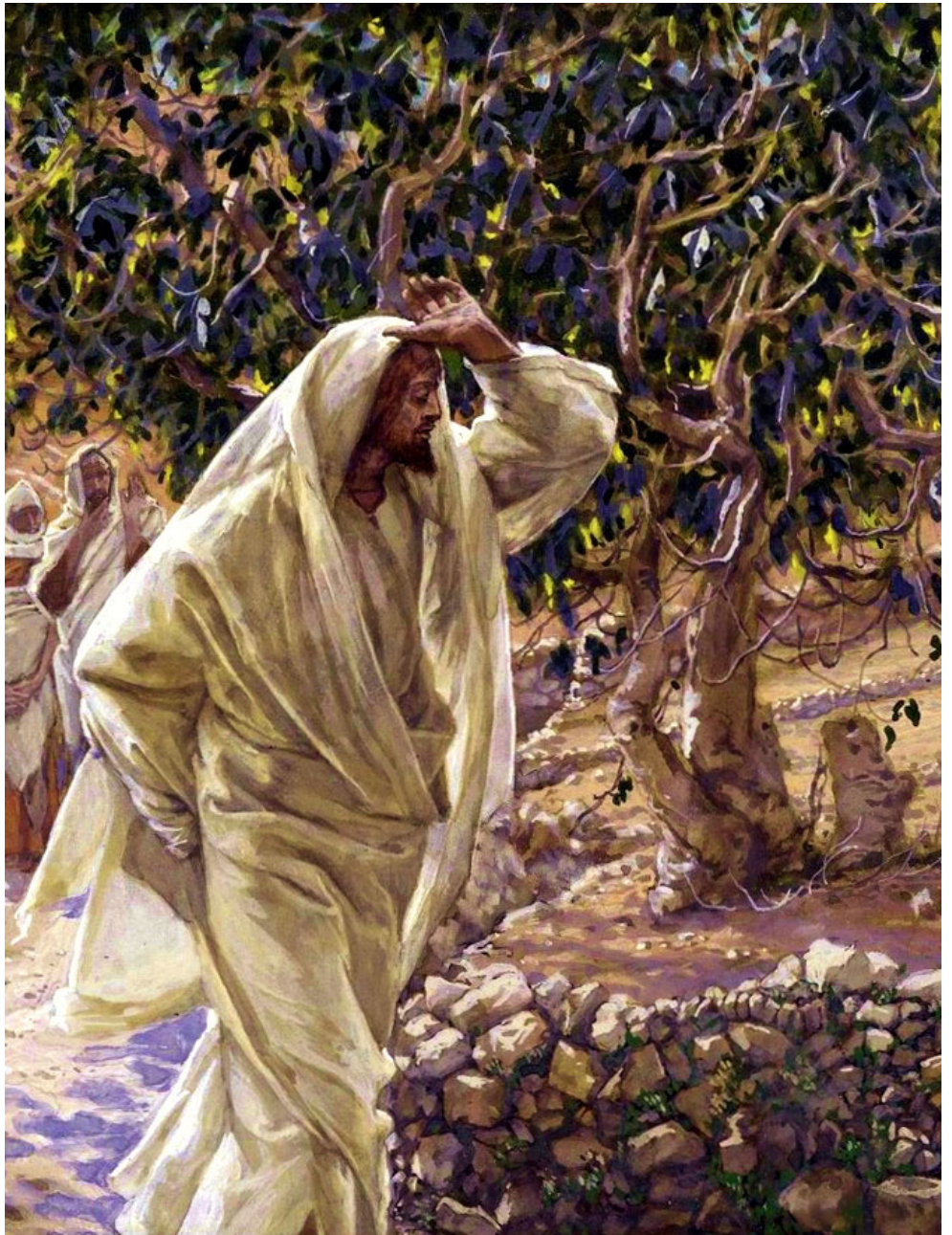

SEMINARIAN UPDATES

On March 8, 2025 Seminarian Jaime received the ministry of acolyte. This event is the very last stage of a man's priestly formation, right before diaconate and presbyterate. In a nutshell, "Acolyte" derives from a Greek term, akolouthos, which means "server," "companion," or "follower."

In the Roman Catholic Church, a person is installed in the ministry of Acolyte in order to assist the deacon and the priest in liturgical celebrations, especially the Eucharistic Liturgy. Besides the deacon and the priest, the acolyte is the one closest to the altar.

To be instituted as an Acolyte, a seminarian first has to be a candidate and a lector, which means he has to be in formation at least five years. This tradition indicates the significance of the Acolyte's ministry, which is linked closely to the sacred ministry of the priesthood.

The acolyte plays an essential role in the celebration of the Holy Mass. The General Instructions of the Roman Missal clearly indicates his duties (no. 178-193). Two of them are of special significance: setting up the altar and distributing Holy Communion. Let us continue to pray for Sem. Jaime as he moves forward in his seminary formation!

El 8 de marzo de 2025 el seminarista Jaime recibió el ministerio de acólito. Este acontecimiento es la última etapa de la formación sacerdotal de un hombre, justo antes del diaconado y el presbiterado. En pocas palabras, «acólito» deriva de un término griego, akolouthos, que significa «servidor», «compañero» o «seguidor».

En la Iglesia Católica Romana, una persona se instala en el ministerio de Acólito con el fin de asistir al diácono y al sacerdote en las celebraciones litúrgicas, especialmente en la Liturgia Eucarística. Además del diácono y el sacerdote, el acólito es el que está más cerca del altar.

Para ser instituido acólito, un seminarista tiene que ser primero candidato y lector, lo que significa que tiene que estar en formación al menos cinco años. Esta tradición indica la importancia del ministerio del Acólito, estrechamente vinculado al ministerio sagrado del sacerdocio.

El acólito desempeña un papel esencial en la celebración de la Santa Misa. Las Instrucciones Generales del Misal Romano indica claramente sus funciones (n. 178-193). Dos de ellas son especialmente significativas: preparar el altar y distribuir la Sagrada Comunión. Sigamos rezando por Sem. Jaime en su formación seminarística.
