A Message from Father Ethan

Happy Father's Day!!

This weekend we celebrate Father's Day as we honor those father figures who have been witnesses of God's love for us in our lives. Fathers, in a particular way, provide for our well-being and protect us from the dangers of the world. They model for us an image of kindness, forgiveness, and friendship as they help to bring about stability in our families and society.

Father's Day was first officially celebrated in the United States in 1910 through the work of Sonora Smart Dodd. Historically, the celebration of Father's Day traces its roots back to the Middle Ages and the honoring of St. Joseph, the adoptive father of Jesus. St. Joseph held that place for the Heavenly Father here on earth and assisted in the raising of Jesus.

In the Catholic Church, we also call our priests by the title of father. This reference recognizes that just as a father must nourish, instruct, challenge, correct, forgive, listen and sustain their children, the priest must also meet the spiritual needs of those entrusted to his care as well as provide them with the nourishment of God through the sacraments.

As we celebrate Father's Day this weekend, we also honor and celebrate our very own Msgr. Peter Nugent, who this year celebrates his 60th Anniversary of Ordination as a priest!! Msgr. Nugent who was ordained a priest at the age of 26, served as pastor here at St. John Eudes for 10 years. A native of Moncton, New Brunswick (Canada), Msgr. Peter previously taught music and liturgy at St. John's Seminary for 14 years (he earned a master's degree in music from USC), and served 11 years as pastor of Santa Clara Church in Oxnard.

Initially serving as associate pastor and later as pastor for 9 years at St. John the Baptist Church in Baldwin Park, Msgr. Nugent was best known as a co-founder of the influential East Valleys Organization, a community action group formed to help the poor and disenfranchised. In addition to his own esteemed service to the church, Msgr. Peter is also classmates with such high-profile clergy as Cardinal Mahony, Cardinal Levada, and the late Archbishop Niederauer.

Msgr. Peter, we thank you for your service here at St. John Eudes and for being a father to this community!! We love you and are proud of your ministry in the church!!

In the Scriptures this weekend, St. Paul recounts the words of Jesus as he offers the Eucharist, "this is my body that is for you" (1 Cor 11:24). What better words could demonstrate the love of a father. We thank our fathers for your gift of life and love. Happy Father's Day!!

Este fin de semana celebramos el Día del Padre y honramos a aquellas figuras paternas que han sido testigos del amor de Dios para nosotros en nuestras vidas. Los padres, de manera particular, procuran nuestro bienestar y nos protegen de los peligros del mundo. Nos modelan una imagen de bondad, perdón y amistad a medida que ayudan a lograr la estabilidad en nuestras familias y en la sociedad.

El Día del Padre se celebró oficialmente por primera vez en los Estados Unidos en 1910 a través del trabajo de Sonora Smart Dodd. Históricamente, la celebración del Día del Padre se remonta a la Edad Media y al homenaje a San José, el padre adoptivo de Jesús. San José ocupó ese lugar para el Padre Celestial aquí en la tierra y ayudó en la resurrección de Jesús.

En la Iglesia Católica, también llamamos a nuestros sacerdotes por el título de padre. Esta referencia reconoce que, así como un padre debe nutrir, instruir, interpellar, corregir, perdonar, escuchar y sostener a sus hijos, el sacerdote también debe satisfacer las necesidades espirituales de los que se le han confiado su cuidado, así como proporcionarles el alimento de Dios a través de los sacramentos.

¡¡Mientras celebramos el Día del Padre este fin de semana, también honramos y celebramos a nuestro propio Mons. Peter Nugent, que este año celebra su 60º Aniversario de Ordenación Sacerdotal!! Mons. Nugent, quien fue ordenado sacerdote a la edad de 26 años, sirvió como párroco aquí en St. John Eudes durante 10 años. Nativo de Moncton, New Brunswick (Canadá), Mons. Peter anteriormente enseñó música y liturgia en el Seminario de St. John durante 14 años (obtuvo una maestría en música de la USC) y sirvió 11 años como pastor de la Iglesia de Santa Clara en Oxnard.

Inicialmente sirviendo como pastor asociado y luego como pastor durante 9 años en la Iglesia St. John the Baptist en Baldwin Park, Mons. Nugent era más conocido como cofundador de la influyente Organización East Valleys, un grupo de acción comunitaria formado para ayudar a los pobres y marginados. Además de su propio estimado servicio a la iglesia, Mons. Peter también es compañero de clase de clérigos de alto perfil como el Cardenal Mahony, el Cardenal Levada y el difunto Arzobispo Niederauer.

Monseñor ¡Peter, te agradecemos por tu servicio aquí en St. John Eudes y por ser un padre para esta comunidad! ¡Te amamos y estamos orgullosos de tu ministerio en la iglesia!

En las Escrituras de este fin de semana, San Pablo relata las palabras de Jesús al ofrecer la Eucaristía, "Esto es mi Cuerpo, que se entrega por ustedes." (1 Cor 11,24). Qué mejores palabras podrían demostrar el amor de un padre. Agradecemos a nuestros padres por su regalo de vida y amor. ¡¡Feliz Día del Padre!!

THE GIFT OF THE EUCHARIST

Today we hear how Abram encounters Melchizedek, “king of Salem . . . and a priest of God Most High” (Genesis 14:18). Melchizedek appears nowhere else in scripture, but is nonetheless significant. Psalm 110 declares of the great King David, “You are a priest forever, in the line of Melchizedek,” a description later given (in the letter to the Hebrews) to Christ as High Priest.

Early Christians saw in Melchizedek’s bread and wine the bread and wine of the Eucharist; Paul’s account of the Last Supper (in today’s second reading) is the oldest one in scripture. In the Gospel, Luke describes Jesus providing bread for a crowd in words similar to Paul’s, words still used by the Church: Jesus takes bread, gives thanks, breaks it. Together, these three readings reveal how Christian priesthood, Christ’s Real Presence, and the call to serve those in need are all found in the gift of the Eucharist.


