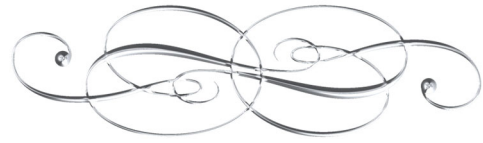

Message FROM THE Pastor



“I have been mercifully treated” (1 Timothy 1:13)

The scriptures this weekend speak to us of God’s patience, tenderness, and mercy.

St. Paul reflects upon his own life of persecution and arrogance, of blasphemy and unbelief. Though his sins are mighty, Paul experienced an even greater power in God’s mercy.

In the Gospel, Jesus encourages us to share that mercy we have received. In the parable of the Prodigal Son, perhaps the greatest and most famous of all of his teachings, Jesus shares the unending love of the Heavenly Father as well as the bitterness and resentment of the elder brother.

This parable cautions us all in how we are receiving, living, and sharing God’s mercy. The Pharisee’s and scribes were complaining that Jesus was engaging with sinners. They were like the elder brother in the parable story. Not only were they not fully receiving the joy of the Kingdom in their own lives, but they were preventing others from experiencing the joy of God’s Kingdom.

St. Paul puts it succinctly; “Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners. Of these I am the foremost.” (1 Timothy 1:15)

May we all have the grace to recognize our shortcomings and our need for God’s mercy, and to humbly that share mercy with others.

Did you know? September 10-11 || How to respond to choking, part one

In a choking emergency, it is important to respond quickly and effectively. Experts suggest reviewing maneuvers regularly so that you are equipped to respond to such an emergency. For children over the age of one, if a child is coughing, encourage him to keep coughing — this could be the quickest way to clear the airway. If a child is having trouble coughing, talking, or breathing, provide immediate help. You can attempt the Heimlich maneuver to dislodge the object and clear the airway. Cómo responder a la asfixia, primera parte

En una emergencia por atragantamiento, es importante responder rápida y eficazmente. Los expertos sugieren revisar los primeros auxilios para asfixia periódicamente para estar preparado para responder a una emergencia de este tipo. Para los niños mayores de un año, si un niño está tosiendo, anímelo a seguir tosiendo; esta podría ser la forma más rápida de despejar las vías respiratorias. Si un niño tiene problemas para toser, hablar o respirar, proporcione ayuda inmediata. Puede intentar la maniobra de Heimlich para ayudarlo a expulsar el objeto y despejar las vías respiratorias. 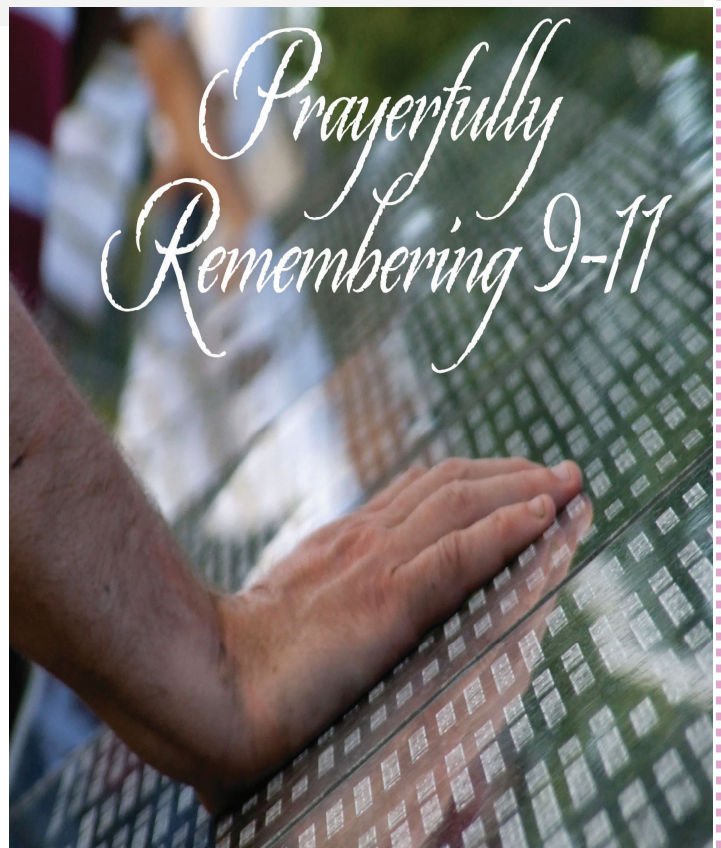

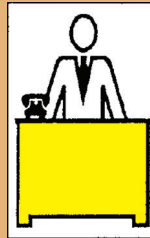
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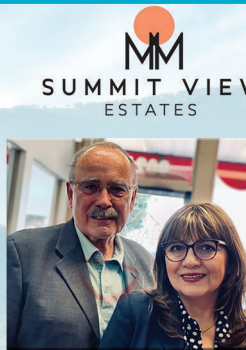
