A Message from the Pastor

Dear St. John Eudes family,

In this weekend's Gospel passage we get the kind of sensationalism that we may expect to find on cable news or social media!

Jesus comments on the news that was surely spreading through their communities regarding the 18 people who tragically died when the tower at Siloam fell on them. It sounds just like one of the news cycles that we hear today - "horrible accident happens and people were killed. Who was at fault?!!!"

He also shares about how Pilate had slaughtered a number of Galileans and mixed their blood with a religious sacrifice. What a horrific example of religious persecution!!

Sadly these types of events still occur in our day and age... and still capture our attention. Jesus is cautioning us to not get caught up in the drama of the events. You can almost hear the buzz going around the town, "did you hear what happened?!", "can you believe it?!", "are they coming for us next?!", "it must be a punishment from God!"... and so on and so on.

Jesus encouraged his listeners and encourages all of us today to pay attention to what is important; our relationship with God. Our attention, our energy can be so easily manipulated and captured by the news of the day, or even the news of the hour. How is our relationship with God? Are we checking in with God as often as we check in with our cellphones?

This is already our Third Sunday in Lent. Time is marching on. What is God speaking to us today? Where is God leading us?

Am I bearing fruit in the Kingdom of God?

¡En el pasaje del Evangelio de este fin de semana tenemos el mismo tipo de sensacionalismo que podemos esperar encontrar en las noticias o en las redes sociales!

Jesús comenta las noticias que seguramente se estaban difundiendo por sus comunidades con respecto a las 18 personas que murieron trágicamente cuando la torre de Siloé cayó sobre ellos. Suena como algunas de las noticias que escuchamos hoy en día: "ocurre un accidente horrible y gente murió. ¿Quién tuvo la culpa?!!!"

También cuenta cómo Pilato había matado a varios galileos y mezclado su sangre con un sacrificio religioso. ¡Qué horrible ejemplo de persecución religiosa!

Lamentablemente, este tipo de eventos todavía ocurren en nuestros días y épocas... y también ahora logran captar nuestra atención. Jesús nos está advirtiendo que no nos dejemos atrapar por el drama de los acontecimientos. Casi se puede escuchar el zumbido que recorre la ciudad, "¡¿escuchaste lo que pasó?!", "¡¿Puedes creerlo?!", "¡¿vendrán por nosotros a continuación?!", "¡debe ser un castigo de Dios!" ... y así sucesivamente.

Jesús animó a sus oyentes y nos anima a todos nosotros hoy a prestar atención a lo que es importante; nuestra relación con Dios. Nuestra atención, nuestra energía pueden ser fácilmente manipuladas y capturadas por las noticias del día, o incluso por las noticias de la hora. ¿Cómo es nuestra relación con Dios? ¿estamos checando con Dios con la misma frecuencia con la que checamos nuestros teléfonos celulares?

Este es ya nuestro tercer domingo de Cuaresma. El tiempo avanza. ¿Qué nos está hablando Dios hoy? ¿A dónde nos lleva Dios?

¿Estoy dando fruto en el Reino de Dios?


