A Message from the Pastor

Dear St. John Eudes family,

This weekend we celebrate Palm Sunday, which marks the beginning of Holy Week.

We recognize that this Sunday begins with Jesus entering the city of Jerusalem and his followers are waving palms in celebration for his arrival. By the end of this day, we experience the crucifixion, death, and burial of Christ. It seems so shocking and almost too much to bear; such a reversal in so short a time.

Many psychological theories present a common framework for the development and stages of relationships. They often begin with **infatuation** (honeymoon phase) which features intense emotions and the idealization of the partner. Everything feels new and things are overlooked.

A second stage is often recognized as the **building** phase in which partners start to deepen their bond. This involves trust building, shared experiences, and a more formal commitment to each other. Reality eventually sets in and this is frequently called **disillusionment**. Partners begin to notice flaws, differences, and unmet expectations. Idealized images fade and conflicts may arise.

This sets the stage for struggle or a **crisis** moment. It's a turning point; some work through the unresolved issues while others drift apart. For those who persist, there is an adjustment period of reconstruction or **acceptance**. This stage involves adapting to reality as love matures into a deeper, more realistic form. As disillusionment is processed the relationship settles into a steady rhythm of **stability**, or long-term love.

As the disciples journey with Jesus, they also experience these different stages of relationship with him. At first, they are captivated by his miracles and preaching, and eventually leave everything to follow him. Holy Week captures the disillusionment phase of their relationship as they realize Jesus is not the messiah they were expecting.

Some of us may have experienced unmet expectations on our journey of Lent this year. Maybe things have not gone as we planned or hoped they would. All is not lost. Jesus assures us through his Resurrection that he is still with us and there is a greater hope than we could have ever hoped for.

We are invited to enter into the fullness of Love with Jesus during this most holy of weeks.

Un Mensaje del Pastor

Querida familia de San Juan Eudes:

Este fin de semana celebramos el Domingo de Ramos, que marca el inicio de la Semana Santa.

Reconocemos que este domingo comienza con la entrada de Jesús a la ciudad de Jerusalén y sus seguidores agitan palmas en celebración por su llegada. Al final de ese día, experimentamos la crucifixión, la muerte y el entierro de Cristo. Parece tan impactante y muy abrumador; Semejante reversión en tan poco tiempo.

Muchas teorías psicológicas presentan un marco común para el desarrollo y las etapas de las relaciones. A menudo comienzan con **el enamoramiento** (fase de luna de miel) que se caracteriza por emociones intensas y la idealización de la pareja. Todo se siente nuevo y las cosas se pasan por alto.

Una segunda etapa a menudo se reconoce como la fase **de construcción** en la que las parejas comienzan a profundizar su vínculo. Esto implica la construcción de confianza, experiencias compartidas y un compromiso más formal con los demás. La realidad finalmente se impone y esto se llama con frecuencia **desilusión**. Las parejas comienzan a notar defectos, diferencias y expectativas insatisfechas. Las imágenes idealizadas se desvanecen y pueden surgir conflictos.

Esto prepara el escenario para un problema o un **momento de crisis**. Es un punto de inflexión; Algunos trabajan a través de los problemas no resueltos, mientras que otros se distancian. Para aquellos que persisten, hay un período de ajuste de reconstrucción o **aceptación**. Esta etapa implica adaptarse a la realidad a medida que el amor madura en una forma más profunda y realista. A medida que se procesa la desilusión, la relación se establece en un ritmo constante de **estabilidad**, o amor a largo plazo.

A medida que los discípulos caminan con Jesús, también experimentan estas diferentes etapas de relación con él. Al principio, se sienten cautivados por sus milagros y predicaciones, y finalmente lo dejan todo para seguirlo. Semana Santa captura la fase de desilusión de su relación cuando se dan cuenta de que Jesús no era el mesías que ellos esperaban.

Es posible que algunos de nosotros hayamos experimentado expectativas insatisfechas en nuestro camino de Cuaresma este año. Tal vez las cosas no han salido como lo planeamos o esperábamos. No todo está perdido. Jesús nos asegura a través de su resurrección que todavía está con nosotros y que hay una esperanza más grande de lo que podríamos haber esperado.

Estamos invitados a entrar en la plenitud del Amor con Jesús durante esta semana tan santa.

WE VET CLERGY

Clergy and Seminarians comply with Safe Environment requirements and all visiting priests and deacons must present a **Statement of Suitability**.

ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY

Clergy or lay persons, if found to have abused a minor, are **permanently removed**.
