CATHOLICS, Did you Know?

Most Catholics would agree that missing Mass on Sundays and Holy Days is a sin. After all, one of the commandments is to keep holy the Sabbath. However, there are many Catholics who were not adequately taught, and therefore don't realize this is a grave sin - on the order of a mortal sin. This question seemed to be the best place to start a new column to help Catholics understand more about their faith.

Why is this so serious? Because of what the Mass is. It is the summit, the high point, the extreme, the most complete expression of being Catholic. At Mass God speaks to us through the readings and the priest's homily, and then Jesus himself comes to us on the altar, in the bread which is now his body - both flesh and divine. During this heavenly meeting the Lord is pouring his grace into us, always working for our salvation which continues our whole life. This is what makes us Catholic. Without the Mass we miss all of this, we become unhealthy, spiritually

undernourished, cut off from God's divine life. Is it any wonder God made worship a commandment? Some caveats - those who are sick, infirm, or physically unable to get to Mass are excused. Also, if you are traveling and have no option for Mass you can ask your pastor for a dispensation in advance. This removes the obligation for Mass that Sunday and so no sin occurs.

Willfully turning our backs on God and cutting ourselves off from this divine life is serious. Is it any different than Adam and Eve going against God's will and deciding for themselves what they could do? Fear not! Many of us have gone through periods of laziness or indifference about Mass, and the good news is God is eagerly waiting to welcome us home. His love for us will always be greater than any sin. Jesus gave us the great sacrament of Reconciliation, which is necessary to approach God with our mistakes and receive His forgiveness through the priest. It's supernatural, and forgiveness of serious sins won't happen without the sacrament.

Get back to Holy Mass and let God our Creator live in you. If you have children, don't be the reason they are deprived anymore. To put it into perspective ask yourself - does soccer, tailgating, sleeping late, breakfast out, nice weather, bad weather give me eternal life? Are they my rock when I am suffering and my hope? Once you realize the Mass is what makes us Catholic and has everything you could ever need, you'll do anything to get there.

PLEASE NOTE: The obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days was suspended in March, 2020 when Archbishop Naumann dispensed Catholics in the Archdiocese of KCK due to COVID. No sin has been committed by those missing Mass since then. The dispensation will end on June 6, 2021 when Archbishop Naumann will reinstate the regular obligation to attend Mass. More information will be provided by the Archdiocese through the Leaven.


