

Solemnity of the Assumption, August 15, 2021

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

In this part of the nation, this middle part of August has become the time for transition from summer vacation back to school for elementary, middle and high schoolers. Just as it is a very important time for all families involved, so too, this is an important time of transition for our own parish family.

So very many of you will be caught off guard by the knowledge that our loyal and much-appreciated Administrative Secretary for the pastor and parish and Charity Coordinator, Joyce Bowlin, retires at the end of this week after a remarkable twenty-one years employed here at Holy Angels. Catholics - Did You Know?

Last week we learned that Sacred Scripture is really the breath of God speaking through the written word of prophets and other inspired authors of the books of Scripture, contained in our Bible. We think of the Bible as one large book, divided into the Old and New Testament. Instead, it is really a *collection of books*, a *sort of library*. *There are 46 books in the Old Testament and 27 books in the New Testament. (Catholic Bibles have 7 extra Old Testament books that Protestant Bibles do not (the Deuterocanonical books.) These "books" were written at various points in time by many authors. They include, for example: biography (Gospels), history (Joshua), poetry (Song of Songs), prophecy (Isaiah), law (Leviticus) and letters (St. Paul to Timothy). Some books are not in chronological order. (Ascension Press sells a "Bible Timeline Chart" that illustrates how to read the Bible in order.)*

In ancient times oral history was passed down and written on scrolls. The New Testament authors were primarily Apostles, or those who knew an Apostle. All these scrolls were collected during the first centuries. In the 4th Century, they were investigated, discussed, and deemed worthy to be included as Sacred Scripture by Church authorities, (just like the Old Testament Hebrew Scriptures). Those that did not have reliable witnesses, contained false information, or appeared to be forgeries were not included in what became our Bible. One book that may seem inspired but falls short of inclusion in Sacred Scripture is the Gospel of St. James.

As a whole, the Bible tells a great story of God's relationship with His people, His love for them even when they rebel, and the fulfillment of His plan for salvation through His Son, Jesus Christ. Our Catholic Church deliberately selects Scriptures for Mass that connect together, showing the Old Testament being fulfilled in the New.

St. Jerome says, "Ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ." So pick up your Bible (St. Ignatius Press Catholic Study Bible is great), and delve into the library of treasures stored there. Let God speak to you personally as you let His words and stories lead you to a deeper understanding of Him.




