

The Board of Directors of Holy Angels Cemetery is announcing a grave site price increase effective September 1st of this year.

Current prices are \$700 for a regular grave site and \$400 for a cremation grave site for parishioners, and \$1000 and \$550 for non-parishioner graves sites. After September 1, 2023, prices for parishioners will be \$900 for a regular grave site and \$450 for a cremation grave site. Non-parishioner prices will move to \$1200 for a regular grave site and \$600 for a cremation grave site. These new prices reflect across the board increases in many if not all of our expense items.

If you have been considering purchasing a grave site/s at our parish cemetery, now would be the time and you would save money in the process. If interested contact Keith Creten at 913-271-5721.
