It has gone so very well and has become a beacon of faith, hope, love, light, and peace! It is so wonderfully exciting and inspiring to wrap our minds around the fact that with the great prayer and work done by our parishioners and friends of our parish, we have succeeded in filling Our Lady Queen of the Holy Angels Adoration Chapel with scheduled adorers for all but seventeen hours of each week! We hope and pray to fill all the hours with adorers before too long! Let us work together towards that goal!

It is always hard to come to terms with gathering to put to rest the sacred remains of people we have come to appreciate, to like, to love. But it is especially difficult when they are of such an age not ready to give up their spirit with what we would consider many more years yet to live. We ponder how much more life they had to live if the opportunity had been presented to them and what a difference their lives had meant to so many. Such is the case with two laid to rest this month from Holy Angels.

As much as they desired it, Kelli Burris, and her husband Jeff, sadly were not able to produce any biological children of their own. In her very Christian manner, along with her husband, Jeff, however, they opened their house for various periods of time to those they employed, offering a home for a while to many youth and teenagers who worked for them at Simple Simon's Pizza who found life difficult in their own family homes. And the beautiful thing is the Burrises always counseled the youth to try their best to reconcile with their family. The couple were always so generous and kind in helping out Holy Angels with pizzas for child and youth events and donating much to these endeavors. Kelli was greatly loved and will be sorely missed by so many.

Steve Burghart, a parishioner who was, while he could be, an active member of our traditional choir with family in it, as well as an active Fourth Degree Knight of Columbus, before cancer overtook his life, evidenced a great Catholic Faith with his wife, Kimberlee. They met when she was 15 and he was 16 and dated for five years before they wed. Steve received all of his Sacraments at Most Pure Heart of Mary culminating in his wedding to his high school sweetheart some forty and a half years ago. He became a distinguished pharmacist while using his MBA. Together with his wife - both of whom loved children - when faced with the fact that they also could not bear any biological children of their own, adopted not one, or two, or even three, but ultimately EIGHT children from around the world and invited them with great love and care into their family and home.

It was with a start that one Sunday at 10:30 Mass when he and his daughter, Ava, were singing that it dawned on me that we had crossed paths once before – at a SEARCH retreat weekend at Bishop Ward High School when he was a high school student at Hayden High School. I remember making note of him at that retreat, thinking how genuine and authentic he was, truly devout, and that he would make a good leader someday. How could I have ever guessed then as a high school student that mine would be the last prayer he ever heard as he took his last breath! Steve DID make a good leader, in many ways, but most especially where it counts the most - not as a successful pharmacist, although he was that! - but for all of us, in his Christian witness of great love as a spouse and as a father and having with Kim magnanimous hearts to welcome children to be theirs forever and by bringing them into the family fold of Holy Mother Church. What a legacy he and Kim have bequeathed to their children, extended family, friends and our parish!

I would like to share the beautiful Catholic prayer that I prayed with Steve as he took his last breath:

> Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, I give you my heart and my soul!

> Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, assist me in my last

Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, may I breathe forth my soul in peace with yours!
