Feast of St. Matthew the Apostle

Dear Parish Family and Friends of Holy Angels,

It is GREAT to have returned to Holy Angels Parish after quite the Odyssey. For those of a classic film appreciation, you may have heard – or better viewed – the 1994 romantic comedy, “Four Weddings and a Funeral.” It is a light-hearted, well-directed, fun-loving British romp, as I remember having seen it as a very young man. My vacation was to be built around a wonderful wedding of a great young man from our parish, who had gone through and took seriously, RCIA, while he was a senior in high school here. He was marrying a Catholic young lady from the South Shore of New Jersey, ocean beach country: Ocean City or Somers Point, to be most exact, and I was asked to officiate. I had planned to go on vacation after that to a hunting lodge in New Jersey and to the Glen Cove Canonry of St. Leopold, of the canons of Klosterneuburg, who had directed our Advent Parish Mission here in 2019 and our Parish Retreat this very last Lent. Providence intervened and my vacation turned into “A Wedding and Four Funerals” in which I was involved. As you can guess, I was not so desirous to have the obverse of the film. But one funeral took me to Memphis, TN, another to Albany, NY, and two others were here in the metro area between a trip to stay at my cousin’s home.

Happily, I was able to enjoy some down time at the beach, in midtown Manhattan, and on Long Island. After one sleepless night and realizing I had been through seven states in 24 hours and nine airport runs in 36 hours at the start of the trip, I was not looking forward to more travel ... especially after a seminary classmate had his flight cancelled 3 straight times, changed airports at midnight in NYC, made it to several hundred miles from his home and then had another cancelled flight, took a train to his hometown, had his brother collect him at the train station and take him to his city’s airport where his car was parked ... feeling for all the world, he said, like a zombie and making it in time to preside at the Saturday vigil Mass. Another friend said all the flights in that “midwestern” – really ‘near east!’ – city were cancelled the night she was flying. She spent the night at the airport.

It does seem airline travel is ever more an adventure, and ever more uncertain as to whether one will make it to his destination – on time – or at all. Providence smiled on me by cancelling a flight and allowing me to rebook having just learned one of my best priest friend’s parents had died and allowing me to be there without an upcharge for changing my schedule. It is good to be FLAT on the ground now for some time!

This coming Saturday, I will be at Prairie Star Ranch for our youth’s Confirmation Retreat shriving sins with another couple of priest confessors, and offering the Holy Sacrifice of the Vigil Mass for the participants: upwards of 60 or more including candidates for Confirmation as well as the teachers, assistants, and parent chaperones. Please keep all of these candidates, their sponsors, the teachers, the other priests and myself in your prayers!

Again, it is great to be back home at Holy Angels. I DID miss you all! In the Holiest Hearts of Jesus, Mary and Joseph,

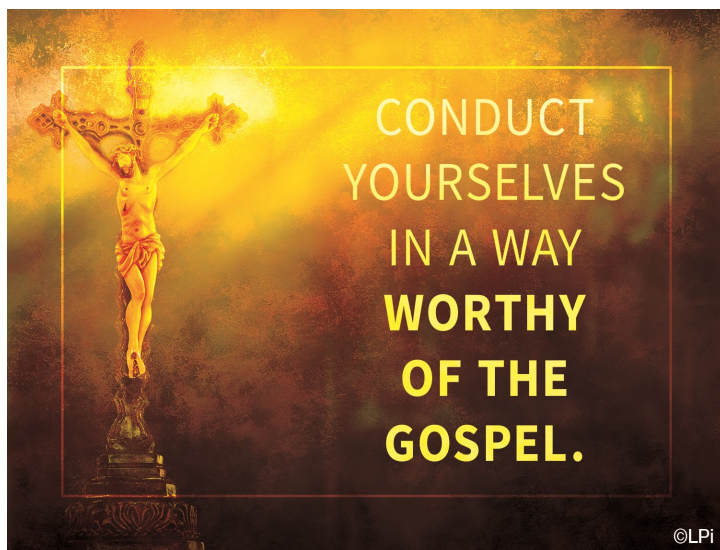
