



Memorial of St. Wenceslaus, Martyr Dear Parish Family and Friends of Holy Angels,

Just last weekend the earth went through the autumnal equinox, and this Sunday heralds the colorful month of October. Yet, today, on the martyr's feast, thoughts are on a favorite Christmas carol: "Good King Wenceslaus." It is the combination of the pleasantly infectious melody, the great lines in the stanzas calling each of us back to living out the tenants of basic Christianity, and the idea of reflecting on having a truly noble, Catholic king as ruler - as truly Catholic culture!

> Good King Wences'las looked out, on the Feast of Stephen, When the snow lay round about, deep and crisp and even; Brightly shone the moon that night, tho' the frost was cruel, When a poor man came in sight, gath'ring winter fuel. "Hither, page, and stand by me, if thou know'st it, telling, Yonder peasant, who is he? Where and what his dwelling?" "Sire, he lives a good league hence, underneath the mountain: Right against the forest fence, by Saint Agnes' fountain." "Bring me flesh, and bring me wine, bring me pine logs hither: Thou and I shall see him dine, when we bear them thither." Page and monarch, forth they went, forth they went together; Through the rude wind's wild lament and the bitter weather. "Sire, the night is darker now, and the wind blows stronger; Fails my heart, I know not how; I can go no longer." "Mark my footsteps, my good page. Tread thou in them boldly. Thou shalt find the winter's rage freeze thy blood less coldly." In his master's steps he trod, where the snow lay dinted; Heat was in the very sod which the saint had printed. Therefore, Christian men, be sure, wealth or rank possessing, Ye who now will bless the poor, shall yourselves find blessing.

The whole calendar of the Church resonates with saints, martyrs and angels. In looking at the Roman Martyrology, one can actually view quite a number of saints for each day of the year. Of course, some are more celebrated some places rather than other places.
