Feast of the Seraphic Saint, St. Francis of Assisi, 2023

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Holy Angels,

Sunday, October 8, is the Silver Jubilee of my seminary classmates from New York to Florida, from Minnesota to Texas, and from Oregon to southern most California, and many places in between, and me literally laying our lives for Our Lord Jesus Christ and His Bride, the Church, to become clergy as we were ordained deacons on the floor of St. Peter's Vatican Basilica at the Altar of the Chair of Peter. Please say a prayer for my classmates: not just for those who have persevered, but for those who have left the clerical state and those who have died. Thank you for doing this.

We are all familiar with the "Prayer of St. Francis" but the founder of the Seraphic Orders of Mendicants, il Poverello of Assisi, composed some other beautiful prayers. A most heroic prayer that he uttered just before receiving the Stigmata – the miraculous identical wounds of Christ from His Holy Cross, the nail wounds in hands and feet and the wound of the spear in His side – is the following:

"O Lord Jesus Christ, two favors I beg of you before I die. The first is that I may, as far as it is possible, feel in my soul and in my body the suffering in which You, O gentle Jesus, sustained in Your bitter Passion. And the second favor is that I, as far as it is possible, may receive in my heart that excessive charity by which You, the Son of God, were inflamed, and which actuated You willingly to suffer so much for us sinners."

Below is the prayer also known as the "Canticle of the Sun."

Praise be to Thee my Lord for our Sister Bodily Death from whom no living man can flee; woe to them who die in mortal sin but blessed they who shall be found in Thy most holy Will; to them the † second death can do no ill harm.
