Pope Francis explains the goal of synodality: “Jesus calls us, as he did the rich man in the Gospel, to empty ourselves, to free ourselves from all that is worldly, including our inward-looking and outworn pastoral models, and to ask ourselves what it is that God wants to say to us at this time—and the direction in which He wants to lead us.”

Two additional aspects of synodality here at St. Charles Borromeo Church:

I. SHARING RESPONSIBILITY FOR OUR COMMON MISSION

- ❖ Synodality is at the service of the mission of the Church, in which all members are called to participate.
- ❖ Since we are all “missionary disciples of Jesus” how is each member of our parish called to participate in the mission of the Church?
- ❖ What areas of mission are we neglecting at St. Charles?
- ❖ Is our sense of mission obvious, vibrant and welcome? How can we intensify our mission?
- ❖ Do people living in North Hollywood immediately recognize St. Charles as a welcoming and healing community of believers? If not, how can we move in that direction?

II. DIALOGUE IN CHURCH AND SOCIETY?

- ❖ Dialogue requires perseverance and patience, but it also enables mutual understanding.
- ❖ To what extent do diverse parishioners in our parish come together for dialogue?
- ❖ What are the places and means of dialogue within our parish that we want to implement?
- ❖ How are divergencies of vision, or conflicts and difficulties addressed?
- ❖ What particular issues in the Church and in our parish do we need to pay more attention to, such as young adults? High School youth? Our older parishioners? Our School parents? Our low-income families?
- ❖ Do we have any ongoing dialogue with other parishes in our Deanery to achieve our common mission? Is that something useful for the future?
- ❖ Is St. Charles Parish ready for, and open to, small faith communities across the parish?

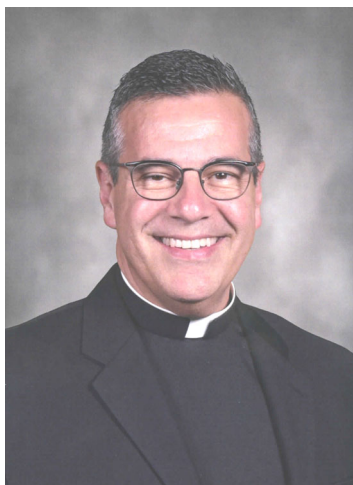

From the desk of Father José,

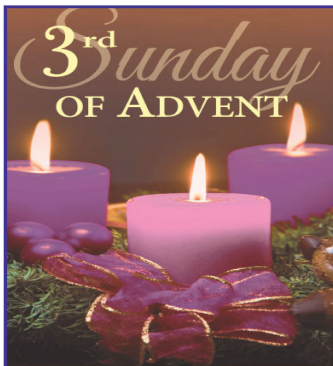

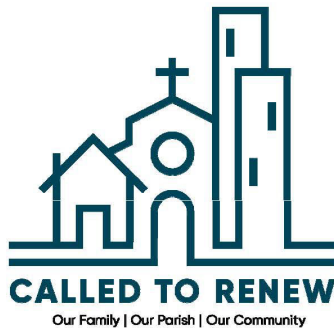

Now the people were filled with expectation, and all were asking in their hearts whether John might be the Christ. John answered them all, saying, "I am baptizing you with water, but one mightier than I is coming. I am not worthy to loosen the thongs of his sandals. 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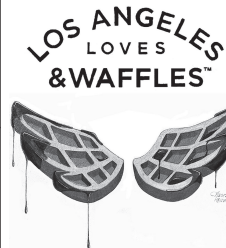
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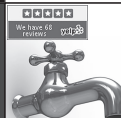
