THE SACRAMENT OF HOLY ORDERS

“Holy Orders is the sacrament through which the mission entrusted by Christ to his apostles continues to be exercised in the Church until the end of time: thus it is the sacrament of apostolic ministry. It includes three degrees: episcopate, presbyterate, and diaconate.”[Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 1536]

- ❖ The priesthood in the Old Testament prefigured the priesthood of Christ. Old Testament priests mediated communion with God through sacrifices and prayer that were repeated many times but could not bring about salvation. Only the one sacrifice of Christ could accomplish our salvation (see Hebrews 5:3; 7:27; 10:1-4).
- ❖ Jesus Christ, in his person, unites God and humanity. Christ heals the division. “There is only one mediator between God and man, himself a Man, Christ Jesus” (1Tm 2:5). On the cross, this God Man “achieved the eternal perfection of all whom he is sanctifying” (Heb 10:14).
- ❖ This priestly ministry of Christ is meant to accomplish the will of the Father to “bring all things into unity under Christ as Head, everything in the heavens and everything on earth” (Eph 1:10).
- ❖ Just as the Eucharist renders present Christ’s self-offering to the Father on Calvary, so the priesthood of Christ is made present through the ministerial priesthood without diminishing the uniqueness of Christ’s priesthood (see CCC 1545). So, the individual “priests” of today are not additional priests but rather sharers in the one priesthood of Jesus Christ that cannot be repeated.

ASPECTS OF MINISTERIAL PRIESTHOOD

- ❖ The Church is the bride of Christ (see Eph 5). The priest signifies Christ the bridegroom. The bridal imagery also illustrates the charism of celibacy, showing that Christ is wedded to the Church.
- ❖ “By the power of the sacrament of Orders, in the image of Christ the eternal high Priest, they are consecrated to preach the Gospel and shepherd the faithful and to celebrate divine worship... Partakers of the function of Christ the sole Mediator...they announce the divine word to all...Let them, as fathers in Christ, take care of the faithful whom they have begotten by baptism and their teaching. (Lumen Gentium, 28).
- ❖ Priests are joined in fraternity with one another and their bishop. “In virtue of their common sacred ordination and mission, all priests are bound together in intimate brotherhood which naturally and freely manifests itself in mutual aid, spiritual as well as material, pastoral as well as personal, in their meetings and in communion of life, of labor and charity” (Lumen Gentium, 28).

THREE DEGREES OF HOLY ORDERS

- ❖ Deacons share in Christ’s ministry of service, according to the image of Christ who made himself the servant of all (see CCC 1570).
- ❖ Bishops serve in the image of Christ as Head of the Church. In them, Christ the High Priest is present in the midst of believers (see Lumen Gentium, 21).
- ❖ Priests are collaborators of the ministry of bishops, often serving as pastor of parishes which concretize the local Church.

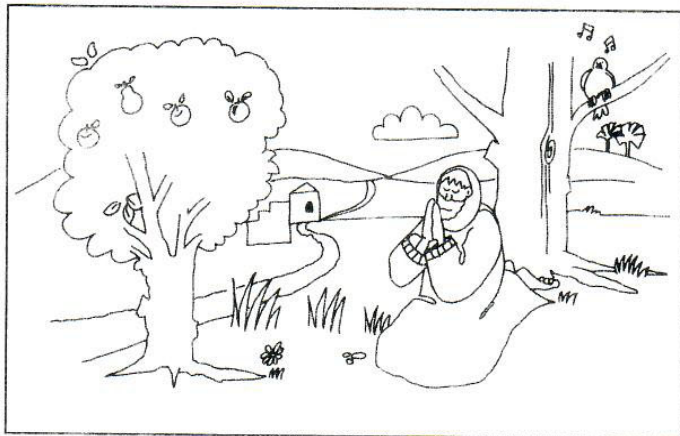

The Ascension of the Lord: Lectionary 58

Glory to God

Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will. We praise you, we bless you, we adore you, we glorify you, we give you thanks for your great glory, Lord God, heavenly King, O God, almighty Father. Lord Jesus Christ, Only Begotten Son, Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us; you take away the sins of the world, receive our prayer; you are seated at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us. For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord, you alone are the Most High, Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father. Amen.

Reading I Acts 1:1-11

In the first book, Theophilus, I dealt with all that Jesus did and taught until the day he was taken up, after giving instructions through the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen. He presented himself alive to them by many proofs after he had suffered, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God. While meeting with them, he enjoined them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for "the promise of the Father about which you have heard me speak; for John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit." When they had gathered together they asked him, "Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?" He answered them, "It is not for you to know the times or seasons that the Father has established by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." When he had said this, as they were looking on, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him from their sight. While they were looking intently at the sky as he was going, suddenly two men dressed in white garments stood beside them. They said, "Men of Galilee, why are you standing there looking at the sky? This Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven will return in the same way as you have seen him going into heaven."

And he put all things beneath his feet and gave him as head over all things to the church, which is his body, the fullness of the one who fills all things in every way.

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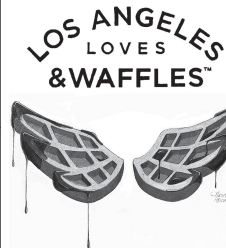
