

## 2. PRAY

An examination of conscience is a prayer practice that Catholics use to reflect on their day, their actions, or to prepare for confession. In verse 21 Jesus says "Whoever has my commandments and observes them is the one who loves me. And whoever loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and reveal myself to him." The commandments are more than just rules, they are an invitation to love.

For this prayer time we invite you to pray an examination of conscience based on the commandments. Begin with the Sign of the Cross. Take three deep breaths. Reflect on the following questions...Have I accepted the invitation to love my mother? My father? My romantic partner? My neighbor? Strangers? My self? God?







# 6<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter: Lectionary 55

## **Glory to God**

Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will. We praise you, we bless you, we adore you, we glorify you, we give you thanks for your great glory, Lord God, heavenly King, O God, almighty Father. Lord Jesus Christ, Only Begotten Son, Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us; you take away the sins of the world, receive our prayer; you are seated at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us. For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord, you alone are the Most High, Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father. Amen.

## **Reading 1 Acts 8:5-8, 14-17**

Philip went down to the city of Samaria and proclaimed the Christ to them. With one accord, the crowds paid attention to what was said by Philip when they heard it and saw the signs he was doing. For unclean spirits, crying out in a loud voice, came out of many possessed people, and many paralyzed or crippled people were cured. There was great joy in that city. Now when the apostles in Jerusalem heard that Samaria had accepted the word of God, they sent them Peter and John, who went down and prayed for them, that they might receive the Holy Spirit, for it had not yet fallen upon any of them; they had only been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.
