

#### **PRAYER**

#### A TRULY WISE PERSON

The ending of today's Gospel speaks about "the new and the old." Jesus is saying that a person "instructed in the kingdom" has wisdom both old and new; in other words, that person learns from the past as well as from the present. Let's look at each of those.

We learn from the past by studying it. So the wisdom of the kingdom comes first from the scriptures. The more familiar we are with the word of God, the more wisdom we possess. We can also learn from the lives of the saints and writings of the Church. If you only have time to go to Mass on Sunday, just listening to the homily can help to apply the scriptures to your life.

One way we can learn from "the new" is to learn from our mistakes. That includes learning from our sins. When we are truly sorry, we make an effort to change our ways. We can also learn from the mistakes and the successes of our friends. As we share our faith with them, we share the stories of our lives, both good and bad. God can speak to us through a friend or relative whose advice we seek. A truly wise person is one who has received a lifetime of good advice.



"This (Blessed) Sacrament above all inflames the soul with divine love. 'God is love

**This is Revival** (1 Jn. IV, 8).' And He is the fire which consumes in our hearts all earthly affections: 'The Lord thy God is a consuming fire (Dt. IV, 24).' Now the Son of God came precisely to kindle this fire of love; 'I am, come to cast fire in the earth', and He added that He did not desire other than to see ignited this holy fire in our hearts: 'and what will I, but that it be kindled? (Lk XII, 49)'. And oh what flames of divine love Jesus Christ ignites in each one who devoutly receives Him!" (St. Alphonsus Liguori).





Una persona verdaderamente sabia

El final del evangelio de hoy habla de "cosas nuevas y cosas antiguas". Jesús está diciendo que una persona "instruida en las cosas del reino" tiene sabiduría tanto antigua como nueva. En otras palabras, esa persona aprende tanto del pasado como del presente. Analicemos a cada uno de ellos.

Aprendemos del pasado estudiándolo. Así que la sabiduría del Reino viene de las escrituras primero. Mientras más nos familiarizamos con la palabra de Dios, más sabiduría poseemos. Además de estudiar las Escrituras, debemos orar con ellas y pedirle al Espíritu Santo que nos demuestre cómo se aplican a nuestras vidas. También podemos aprender de la vida de los santos y de los escritos de la Iglesia. Puede ser que los santos hayan vivido vidas extraordinarias, pero todos comenzaron como personas ordinarias que entregaron sus vidas a Cristo. Los escritos de la Iglesia, aunque a veces muy técnicos, contienen la sabiduría de siglos de vivencia de la fe. Si solo tienes tiempo de ir a Misa los domingos, tan solo escuchar la homilía puede ayudarte a aplicar las Escrituras a tu vida.

Una forma en que podemos aprender de "las cosas nuevas" es aprender de nuestros errores. Eso incluye aprender de nuestros pecados. Cuando nos arrepentimos de verdad, hacemos un esfuerzo por cambiar nuestros hábitos. Se podría decir que tenemos que aprender una nueva forma de responder a esa situación. En la Biblia, la palabra arrepentimiento significa un cambio de corazón, una nueva forma de ver y hacer las cosas.

También podemos aprender de los errores y los éxitos de nuestros amigos. Al compartir nuestra fe con ellos, compartimos las historias de nuestras vidas, tanto las buenas como las malas. Estas historias nos pueden enseñar cómo vivir lo fe (¡o cómo no vivirla!). Una de las ventajas de tener amigos de confianza para poder confesarles nuestras fallas es que no tenemos que descubrir la solución a la vida por nuestra propia cuenta. Dios nos puede hablar a través de un amigo o un familiar cuando les pedimos consejo. Una persona verdaderamente sabia es aquella que ha recibido buenos consejos durante toda la vida. Por Tom Schmidt


