From Fr. Robert...

This Saturday, January 22nd, the anniversary of Roe v. Wade, is the Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children. The Knights of Columbus will be organizing an event in Pioneer Square to show public support for this cause, and I encourage everyone to join them. While this issue necessarily has political implications, it fundamentally transcends politics because of the recognition that human life, no matter how small, is absolutely sacred and an immense gift from God.

Parents are, in a sense, cooperators with God in creation. At the very moment of conception, when the sperm unites with the egg to create a unique human being with unique DNA, God infuses a soul into this little creature -- a soul which is immortal, destined to be united with Him in love for all eternity.

Besides working for the legal protection of the unborn, may the Holy Spirit strengthen us to encourage the protection of life within our families and among our friends. Helping reassure unwed mothers or mothers enduring difficult pregnancies that they are never alone and that they have our 100% support is a beautiful means of promoting life. Another way that I think is too often overlooked is discouraging the use of RU486, also known as the "abortion pill", as well as the "morning after pill" or the "plan B" pill. Both of these, no matter how widely available and accepted, have the potential to take the life of an unborn baby, a human being with a God-given soul and unique DNA. It is never morally acceptable to take these pills. Once again, the encouragement of family and friends can help people understand, when perhaps before they were unaware, how sacred life is, how God loves life and gives grace to parents, how promoting life is worth making sacrifices for, how we as a community support those in difficulty, and how we love and support families and children. May God's true peace reign on earth, in our families, and in our community.

Este sábado 22 de enero, aniversario de Roe v. Wade, es el Día de Oración por la Protección Legal de los Niños por Nacer. Los Knights de Columbus organizarán un evento en Pioneer Square para mostrar el apoyo público a esta causa, y animo a todos a unirse a ellos. Si bien este tema necesariamente tiene implicaciones políticas, trasciende fundamentalmente la política debido al reconocimiento de que la vida humana, por pequeña que sea, es absolutamente sagrada y un inmenso regalo de Dios.

Los padres son, en cierto sentido, cooperadores con Dios en la creación. En el mismo momento de la concepción, cuando el espermatozoide se une al óvulo para crear un ser humano único con un ADN único, Dios infunde un alma en esta pequeña criatura, un alma que es inmortal, destinada a estar unida a Él en amor por toda eternidad.

Además de trabajar por la protección legal de los no nacidos, que el Espíritu Santo nos fortalezca para fomentar la protección de la vida dentro de nuestras familias y entre nuestros amigos. Ayudar a asegurar a las madres solteras o las madres que soportan embarazos difíciles que nunca están solas y que cuentan con nuestro 100% de apoyo es una hermosa manera de promover la vida. Otra forma que creo que con demasiada frecuencia se pasa por alto es desaconsejar el uso de RU486, también conocida como la "píldora abortiva", así como la "píldora del día después" o la píldora "plan B". Ambos, sin importar qué tan ampliamente disponibles y aceptados estén, tienen el potencial de quitarle la vida a un bebé por nacer, un ser humano con un alma dada por Dios y un ADN único. Nunca es moralmente aceptable tomar estas pastillas. Una vez más, el aliento de familiares y amigos puede ayudar a las personas a comprender, cuando tal vez antes no lo sabían, cómo sagrada es la vida, cómo Dios ama la vida y da gracia a los padres, cómo vale la pena sacrificarse por promover la vida, cómo nosotros como comunidad apoyar a los que tienen dificultades, y cómo amamos y apoyamos a las familias y los niños. Que la verdadera paz de Dios reine en la tierra, en nuestras familias y en nuestra comunidad.

Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children

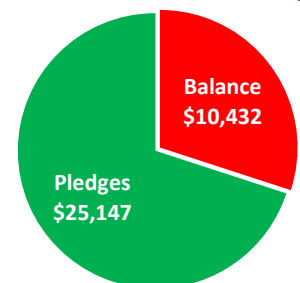
January 22 is designated as a particular day of prayer and penance, called the “Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children”.
