From Fr. Robert. . .

Parish Mission is this week

Welcome, Fr. Greg Bramlage and team, for our parish mission this week! As we remember from last year, the healing we experience from God -- physical healing, emotional healing, healing of relationships with God and others -- is all empowered by the Holy Spirit, the very love of God poured into our hearts (see Rom 5:5).

The novena we've been praying to the Holy Spirit has been a beautiful and powerful means of opening our hearts to the Holy Spirit. "Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and enkindle in them the fire of your love!" What if every Catholic took that prayer seriously? How different would our church and community be?

I want to share a passage from a book I've been reading on the Holy Spirit. *The Sanctifier* was written by Archbishop Luis Martines of Mexico City, who died in 1956.

"The word 'give,' 'gift,' has a meaning proper to the Holy Spirit... It is characteristic of love to give gifts, but the first gift, the gift par excellence, is love itself. The Holy Spirit is the Love of God; therefore He is the Gift of God... Now to the giving on the part of God corresponds possession on our part. We have what God has given us. The Holy Spirit is then something of our own and we can call Him, according to St. Thomas, 'the spirit of man, or a gift bestowed upon man.'... Have we thought of what possession of the Gift of God means in our souls? Have we thought of the divine significance of that rigorously exact phrase: 'The Holy Spirit is ours'? Possession is proper to love. In its first stage it is a desire of possession; perfect love is the joy of possession..."


